- $\underline{\text{SECTION 1.}}$ (1) This section shall be known as the "Restore
- 6 the Right to Vote Act."
- 7 (2) (a) Any disqualification from voting arising from a
- 8 felony conviction shall be terminated, and voting rights shall be
- 9 restored upon completion of time sentenced in prison. No
- 10 disqualification from voting shall be imposed as a condition of
- 11 parole, probation or any outstanding fines or fees.
- 12 (b) Upon release from prison, a person must be given an
- 13 official document which provides:
- 14 (i) That the person has been released from prison;
- 15 (ii) That the person is restored to the civil
- 16 right to vote; and
- 17 (iii) A description of how to register to vote.
