## SENATE BILL NO. 2425

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-907, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO FURTHER DEFINE TERMS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 23-15-907, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 6 23-15-907. (1) A person shall not knowingly collect and
- 7 transmit a ballot that was mailed to another person, except as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) An election official while engaged in official
- 10 duties as authorized by law.
- 11 (b) An employee of the United States Postal Service
- 12 while engaged in official duties as authorized by law.
- 13 (c) Any other individual who is allowed by federal law
- 14 to collect and transmit United States mail while engaged in
- 15 official duties as authorized by law.
- 16 (d) A family member, household member \* \* \* or
- 17 caregiver of the person to whom the ballot was mailed.

18	(e) A common carrier that transports goods from one
19	place to another for a fee. No parcel shall contain more than a
20	single ballot.
21	(2) For the purposes of this section, with respect to a
22	person to whom the ballot was mailed:
23	(a) "Caregiver" means an individual who provides
24	medical or health care assistance to such person in a residence,
25	nursing care institution, hospice facility, assisted living
26	center, assisted living facility, assisted living home,
27	residential care institution, adult day health care facility or
28	adult foster care home.
29	(b) "Family member" means an individual who is related
30	to such person by blood, marriage, adoption or legal guardianship
31	(c) "Household member" means an individual who resides
32	at the same residence as such person.
33	(3) Any violation of this section shall be subject to the
34	penalties of Section 97-13-37.
35	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
36	and after July 1, 2024.
