- 8 (a) "Residency" shall be synonymous with domicile.
- 9 (b) "Residency" shall also mean the address that is the
- 10 principal physical location that is occupied by a person in
- 11 Mississippi. A person establishes residency in a location where
- 12 the person lives and has the intent to remain. This intent can be
- 13 evidenced by the address a person uses for Homestead exemption
- 14 purposes, a person's address on his or her driver's license or
- 15 other identification issued by the Mississippi Driver Service
- 16 Bureau, a person's voter registration, legal documents where a
- 17 person swears by penalty or perjury of law of the address of their
