## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2502

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2	SHORTEN THE REQUIREMENT FOR NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETINGS OF COUNTY
3	BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS FROM FIVE DAYS TO THREE DAYS; AND FOR
4	RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 19-3-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- 7 amended as follows:
- 19-3-19. (1) The board of supervisors may, at a regular 8
- meeting, by an order on its minutes, adjourn to meet at any time 9
- 10 it may determine upon.
- 11 The president, or the vice president in the absence or
- 12 disability of the president, or any three (3) members of the
- board, may call special meetings when deemed necessary. Notice 13
- 14 shall be given of all special meetings, for at least \* \* \* three
- 15 (3) days, by advertisement posted at the courthouse door, or
- published in a newspaper of the county, and the notice thereof, 16
- 17 whether posted or published in a newspaper, shall be entered in
- full on the minutes of said meeting. The notice of a special 18
- meeting \* \* \* shall specify each matter of business to be 19

- 20 transacted thereat, and at such special meetings business shall
- 21 not be transacted which is not specified in the order or notice
- 22 for such meeting.
- 23 (3) The president, or the vice president in the absence or
- 24 disability of the president, or any two (2) members of the board,
- 25 may by written notice, call an emergency meeting of the board of
- 26 supervisors in cases of an emergency arising as a result of
- 27 serious damage to county property, or to roads or bridges, or
- 28 emergencies arising as a result of epidemic conditions or weather
- 29 conditions. The notice shall state the time of the meeting and
- 30 distinctly specify the subject matters of business to be acted
- 31 upon and be signed before a notary by the officer or officers
- 32 calling the meeting. At least three (3) hours before the time
- 33 fixed for the meeting, notice shall be personally delivered to the
- 34 members of the board who have not signed it and who can be found.
- 35 The notice shall also be posted at the courthouse door at least
- 36 three (3) hours before the time fixed for the meeting. If a
- 37 member of the board cannot be found to complete the personal
- 38 delivery of the notice, the president, vice president or any one
- 39 of the two (2) members of the board calling an emergency meeting
- 40 shall make every attempt, within the applicable notice period, to
- 41 contact the board member that was not personally found by other
- 42 available means, including, but not limited to, telephone or
- 43 e-mail. The method of notice used to call the meeting shall be

- 44 entered on the minutes of the emergency meeting, and business not
- 45 specified in the notice shall not be transacted at the meeting.
- 46 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after July 1, 2024.
