SENATE BILL NO. 2562

1 AN ACT TO ENACT THE TIM TEBOW ACT TO AUTHORIZE HOMESCHOOLED 2 STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR 3 ACTIVITIES SPONSORED BY OR ENGAGED IN BY THE PUBLIC SCHOOL TO 4 WHICH THE STUDENT WOULD BE ASSIGNED ACCORDING TO DISTRICT SCHOOL 5 BOARD ATTENDANCE POLICIES TO PROVIDE CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH 6 STUDENTS; TO PROVIDE THAT TRANSPORTATION OF THE STUDENT TO THE 7 PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT, GUARDIAN OR STUDENT; TO PROHIBIT A PUBLIC SCHOOL FROM DISCRIMINATING 8 9 AGAINST SUCH STUDENT IN THE SELECTION OF INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR TEAM MEMBERS; TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH PARTICIPATION 10 11 SHALL BE CONSIDERED A PRIVILEGE AND NOT A RIGHT AND THAT NOTHING 12 IN THE ACT SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO CREATE A CAUSE OF ACTION; TO 13 CREATE THE "HOMESCHOOL EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY FUND" AS A SPECIAL FUND WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; TO PROVIDE THAT DISTRICTS 14 15 MAY RECEIVE \$2,250.00 PER HOMESCHOOL STUDENT THAT PARTICIPATED IN 16 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES IN THE PRIOR YEAR; TO REQUIRE THE 17 DEPARTMENT TO REPORT DISBURSEMENTS TO THE OFFICE OF THE STATE 18 AUDITOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

20 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, unless the context

21 requires otherwise:

(a) "Homeschool" means a legitimate home instruction

23 program as provided under Section 37-13-91(3)(c).

(b) "Interscholastic extracurricular activity" means

25 any school-authorized sport or activity sanctioned by the

26 Mississippi High School Activity Association.

27 (c) "Appropriate documentation" for purposes of this28 section means:

(i) The results of a nationally recognized
standardized test or its equivalence determined by the Mississippi
Department of Education;

(ii) A portfolio of the previous year's school work demonstrating the student's proficiency appropriate for his or her grade level at the discretion of the school principal or counselor staff; or

(iii) If the student was enrolled in a public, private, parochial or charter school during the immediately preceding school year, the student's eligibility is based on his or her academic success at that school.

A student enrolled in a homeschool shall be 40 (2)(a) 41 eligible to participate in interscholastic extracurricular 42 activities sponsored by or engaged in by the public school to 43 which the student would be assigned according to district school board attendance policies; provided, that homeschooled students 44 45 who leave a public school during the school year are subject to 46 the same transfer protocols that apply to public-to-public 47 transfers. A student eligible under this section who is selected to participate in extracurricular activities shall: 48

49 (i) Pay any participation or activity fee in an50 amount equal to the fee charged to public school participants;

54 Adhere to the same academic standards as (iii) 55 other participants, with those standards confirmed by appropriate 56 documentation provided by the student to the public school providing the extracurricular activity in which the student will 57 58 participate. A parent or person standing in parental relation to 59 a homeschooled student participating in the extracurricular activity must periodically, in accordance with the school's 60 61 grading calendar, provide written verification to the school indicating that the student is receiving a passing grade in each 62 63 course or subject being taught;

64 (iv) Register with the school his or her intent to 65 participate in extracurricular activity as a representative of the 66 school before the beginning date of the semester for the activity 67 in which he or she wishes to participate; and

(v) Comply with the same physical examination,
immunization, insurance, age and semester eligibility requirements
as other students participating in the activity.

(b) Transportation of the student to the public school to participate in interscholastic extracurricular activities shall be the responsibility of the parent, guardian or student. The student may use the same transportation as other students as long as additional expenses are not incurred by the district.

student eligible under this section in the selection of
interscholastic extracurricular team members.

(3) Participation in an interscholastic extracurricular activity is a privilege and not a right. Nothing in this act shall be interpreted to create a cause of action on behalf of a student against a public school or public school district official or against an interscholastic extracurricular activities association.

85 With respect to a homeschooled student's education (4) 86 program, nothing in this section shall be construed to permit an 87 agency of the state, a public school district or any other 88 governmental body to exercise control, regulatory authority or 89 supervision over a homeschooled student or parent or person standing in parental relation to a homeschooled student beyond the 90 91 control, regulatory or supervision required to participate in 92 league activity.

93 (5) School districts may apply to the Mississippi Department
94 of Education for additional funding to cover the cost of any
95 homeschooled students participating in extracurricular activities.

96 (6) Application for funds must be made to the Mississippi
97 Department of Education on or before January 30 of each school
98 year.

99 (7) The application must include the number of homeschool100 students participating in extracurricular activities in the prior

101 school year, the activities in which the homeschool student 102 participated and such other information as required by the 103 Mississippi Department of Education.

104 (8) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund to 105 be designated the "Homeschool Extracurricular Activity Fund" to be 106 administered by the Department of Education.

107 Districts applying for funds under this section shall (9) receive Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,250.00) per 108 109 homeschool student that participated in extracurricular activities 110 in the prior year. Distributions shall be made by the Department 111 of Education from the "Homeschool Extracurricular Activity Fund." The Department of Education shall allocate funds to the Homeschool 112 113 Extracurricular Activity Fund as needed to ensure the fund never 114 exhausts.

(10) Nothing in this section shall be construed as to require a school district to request funding.

(11) The Department of Education shall report disbursements made pursuant to this section to the Office of the State Auditor, on a form proscribed by the Office of the State Auditor, on July 1, 2024 and every two (2) years thereafter.

121 (12) This section may be known and be cited as the "Tim 122 Tebow Act."

123 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 124 and after July 1, 2024.
