## SENATE BILL NO. 2652

AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL PERSONS 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO PROCURE A WILD TURKEY STAMP BEFORE HUNTING WILD TURKEYS IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO ESTABLISH THE FEE AND PROVIDE FOR THE FURNISHING OF THE STAMP; TO SET PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; TO PROVIDE THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH FUNDS RAISED FROM THE SALE OF STAMPS MAY BE EXPENDED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section, the
- 9 following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed
- 10 herein unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 (a) "Wild turkey" means the game bird Meleagris
- 12 gallopavo.
- 13 (b) "Stamp" means the state wild turkey stamp, either
- 14 in its physical or electronic form, furnished by the commission.
- 15 A stamp is a specialized permit required for hunting wild turkeys,
- 16 with proceeds directly dispersed into the conservation,

- 17 management, protection or scientific research of wild turkeys.
- 18 (c) "Harvest tag" means the physical or electronic tool
- 19 used to serve as an inventory of the annual bag limit allotted to
- 20 individual wild turkey hunters. Harvest tags are invalidated upon

- 21 the harvest of a wild turkey. Physical tags may be required to be
- 22 attached to the wild turkey following harvest.
- 23 (d) "Nongovernmental entity" means a nonprofit
- 24 organization primarily concerned with the protection and
- 25 conservation of land and natural resources, as evidenced by its
- 26 organizational documents.
- 27 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person sixteen (16) years
- 28 of age or older to hunt or take wild turkeys during any open wild
- 29 turkey season in the State of Mississippi without first having
- 30 procured a stamp. The electronic stamp on file with the
- 31 commission shall serve as proof of procurement.
- 32 (3) The fee to resident hunters for each stamp shall be Ten
- 33 Dollars (\$10.00). The commission shall set the fee for
- 34 nonresident wild turkey hunters as provided in Section 49-7-8.
- 35 Each stamp shall be valid through the final day of the spring wild
- 36 turkey season following its purchase. After its expiration,
- 37 another stamp must be procured in order to hunt or take wild
- 38 turkeys in a future open wild turkey season.
- 39 (4) The commission may make the procurement of harvest tags
- 40 dependent upon the purchase of a stamp.
- 41 (5) The commission shall determine the form of the stamp.
- 42 The commission shall furnish physical stamps to bonded agents for
- 43 issuance or sale in the same manner as other types of licenses or
- 44 shall cause the electronic stamp to accrue to the purchaser's
- 45 benefit when purchased from an automated point-of-sale source.

- 46 (6) Any person violating any of the provisions of this
- 47 section shall be quilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
- 48 shall be fined not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more
- 49 than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) as prescribed in Section
- 50 49-7-101.
- 51 (7) All revenue from the proceeds of stamps shall only be
- 52 used and expended for the following objectives:
- 53 (a) Paying administrative or processing costs
- 54 associated with a physical or electronic harvest tag program, or
- 55 any other program governing or regulating the harvest of wild
- 56 turkeys;
- 57 (b) Restoring, enhancing or protecting wild turkey
- 58 populations or their habitats on public or private lands in
- 59 Mississippi as prescribed by the department;
- (c) Funding scientific research, as conducted by
- 61 qualified professionals, into the ecology or management of wild
- 62 turkeys, their habitats or their predators; and
- 63 (d) Increasing access to publicly available turkey
- 64 hunting opportunities.
- 65 (8) Proceeds from stamps may be used as matching funds or
- 66 fiscal leverage to secure grants or other financial awards are
- 67 deemed to align with the objectives in subsection (7) of this
- 68 section.



- 69 (9) The commission may enter into agreements with other
- 70 state, federal or nongovernmental entities to execute the
- 71 objectives in subsection (7) of this section.
- 72 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a new
- 73 section in Title 49, Chapter 7, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 74 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 75 and after July 1, 2024.
