SENATE BILL NO. 2676

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEMONSTRATION OF PROFICIENCY IN CIVICS AS A CONDITION OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION BY REQUIRING STUDENTS TO TAKE A CIVICS COURSE THAT DEMONSTRATES KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THE HISTORY, PRINCIPLES AND FORM OF 5 GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES; TO REQUIRE THE UNITED STATES 6 HISTORY CURRICULUM TO INCLUDE HISTORICAL KNOWLEDGE BEGINNING WITH 7 THE SETTLEMENT OF JAMESTOWN, VIRGINIA, IN 1607; TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; AND FOR RELATED 8 9 PURPOSES.
- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 SECTION 1. High school graduation requirement; civics
- 12 course. (1) For purposes of this section, "civics course" means
- 13 a course promulgated by the Mississippi Department of Education
- 14 that must demonstrate a knowledge and understanding of the
- fundamentals of the history, principles and form of government of 15
- 16 the United States.
- 17 The State Board of Education shall provide that the
- 18 requirements of this section shall be incorporated into the United
- 19 States History curriculum required for high school students.
- Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, the United States 20
- 21 History curriculum shall include historical knowledge regarding

- 22 the United States of America from the settlement of Jamestown,
- 23 Virginia, in 1607 to the present.
- 24 (3) This section is applicable to any student who graduates
- 25 from high school during or after the 2024-2025 school year.
- SECTION 2. Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 27 amended as follows:
- 28 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish
- 29 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a
- 30 minimum:
- 31 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by
- 32 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of
- 33 Education.
- 34 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits,
- 35 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district
- 36 school board.
- 37 (c) Demonstration of proficiency in civics and United
- 38 States History as prescribed in Section 1 of this act.
- 39 (* * *d) By school, information on high school
- 40 graduation rates. High schools with graduation rates lower than
- 41 eighty percent (80%) must submit a detailed plan to the
- 42 Mississippi Department of Education to restructure the high school
- 43 experience to improve graduation rates.
- 44 (2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
- 45 subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
- 46 in a form prescribed by the State Board of Education.

- 47 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 48 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to
- 49 graduation.
- 50 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after July 1, 2024.
