SENATE BILL NO. 2698

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE CYBER SAFETY REVIEW BOARD; TO STIPULATE 2 THAT THE BOARD SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING A COLLABORATIVE 3 EFFORT TO ADDRESS CYBERSECURITY THREATS TO THE STATE OF 4 MISSISSIPPI; TO NAME THE VOTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD; TO NAME THE 5 EX OFFICIO NONVOTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD; TO ALLOW THE VOTING 6 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO ADD EX OFFICIO NONVOTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AS NECESSARY; TO ALLOW THE BOARD TO ADOPT RULES WHICH GOVERN 7 THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETINGS ACCORDING TO CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS; 8 9 TO REOUIRE THE BOARD TO PRODUCE A CYBERSECURITY REPORT AND PRESENT 10 IT TO THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND CHAIRMEN OF TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEES OF THE 11 12 MISSISSIPPI SENATE AND THE MISSISSIPPI HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; 13 TO REQUIRE THE BOARD TO CREATE A LIST OF BEST CYBERSECURITY PRACTICES FOR DISTRIBUTION; TO CREATE THE CYBER SAFETY REVIEW 14 15 BOARD FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 16 17 SECTION 1. There is hereby created the "Cyber Safety Review Board," which shall be responsible for ensuring a collaborative 18 effort is made to address the cybersecurity threat posed to the 19 20 State of Mississippi. Responsibilities of the board include creating a system of reporting cybersecurity attacks within the 21 22 state, researching and implementing best practices to mitigate 23 cybersecurity risks, and connecting individuals and entities with 24 federal and industry partners.

S. B. No. 2698 G1/2 24/SS26/R1071 PAGE 1 (aa\tb) 25 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Cyber Safety Review Board, hereafter referred 26 to as the "board," shall consist of the following seven (7) 27 members:

(a) The Executive Director of the Mississippi Office of
Homeland Security, or his or her designee, as chairman of the
board;

31 (b) The Executive Director of the Mississippi
32 Department of Information Technology Services, or his or her
33 designee, as vice chairman of the board;

34 (c) The Commissioner of the Department of Public35 Safety, or his or her designee;

36 (d) The Executive Director of the Mississippi Emergency
37 Management Agency, or his or her designee;

38 (e) The Adjutant General of the Mississippi National39 Guard, or his or her designee;

40 (f) The State Superintendent of Education, as appointed 41 by the Mississippi Board of Education, or his or her designee; and 42 (g) The Attorney General of Mississippi, or his or her 43 designee.

44 <u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Ex officio nonvoting members of the board 45 include:

46 (a) The President of the Mississippi Municipal League,
47 or his or her designee;

48 (b) The Executive Director of the Mississippi49 Association of Supervisors staff, or his or her designee; and

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53 (2) The voting members of the Cyber Safety Review Board may 54 vote to expand the board with additional ex officio nonvoting 55 members deemed necessary to provide expertise or access to 56 resources involving cybersecurity.

57 SECTION 4. Within forty-five (45) days of passage of this 58 act, the Executive Director of the Mississippi Office of Homeland 59 Security shall call a meeting of the board. The board shall adopt 60 rules which govern the time of meetings, place of meetings, and the manner of conducting the business of the board. 61 The board 62 shall meet at least monthly and select one (1) of the ex officio nonvoting members of the board to serve as secretary, whose role 63 it shall be to maintain minutes of each meeting of the board. 64 65 After the conclusion of each meeting, the board shall send the 66 minutes of the meeting to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and the Chairmen of the Technology Committees of the Mississippi 67 68 Senate and the Mississippi House of Representatives.

69 A quorum shall be a majority of the voting members of the 70 board.

After twelve (12) consecutive monthly meetings, the board may vote to meet less frequently; however, the board shall meet at least once quarterly.

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**SECTION 5.** The board shall produce a statewide cybersecurity report, which shall be presented to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House, and the Chairmen of the Technology Committees of the Mississippi Senate and Mississippi House of Representatives by December 15 each year. The board shall also develop a list of best practices in cybersecurity to disburse to the boards of supervisors of each county throughout the state.

81 **SECTION 6.** (1) There is created in the State Treasury a 82 special fund to be known as the "Cyber Safety Review Board Fund." Any funds which may be needed for administrative and travel 83 84 expenses shall be deposited in this special fund by the Department 85 of Public Safety from the department's regular support 86 appropriation. The Cyber Safety Review Board Fund is a special 87 trust fund and the interest earned thereon shall be credited to 88 the fund.

(2) The Department of Public Safety shall adopt regulations
for the administration of the fund. The commissioner shall
administer the fund and expenditures may be made from the fund
upon requisition by the commissioner. The department shall spend
monies in the fund by an annual appropriation approved by the
Legislature.

95 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 96 and after July 1, 2024.
