1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 28, CHAPTER 549, LAWS OF 2023, TO

 6 RECEIVED BY JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY FROM THE 2022 IHL CAPITAL  
 7 IMPROVEMENTS FUND; TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-185, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF  
 8 1972, TO DELETE THE PROVISION REFERENCING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
 9 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION AND APPROPRIATION BY THE LEGISLATURE  
 10 FROM THE PROCEDURE FOR THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE 2023 DESOTO  
 11 COUNTY INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS FUND; TO AMEND SECTION  
 12 65-1-187, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE PROVISION

 16 FUND; TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-189, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
 17 DELETE THE PROVISION REFERENCING THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
 18 ADMINISTRATION AND APPROPRIATION BY THE LEGISLATURE FROM THE  
 19 PROCEDURE FOR THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE 2023 GULFPORT COMMERCE  
 20 CORRIDOR FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

22 **SECTION 1.** Section 28, Chapter 549, Laws of 2023, is amended  
 23 as follows:

24 Section 28. Monies transferred pursuant to Sections 1 and 3  
 25 of this act into the 2023 Local Improvements Projects Fund shall  
 26 be disbursed by the Department of Finance and Administration,
