## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2862

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-14-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH MAY COLLECT LICENSING AND ADMINISTRATION FEES FOR CERTAIN RADIOLOGICAL HEALTH SERVICES IN CONGRUENCE WITH FEDERAL REGULATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE 5 BOARD OF HEALTH OR THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF ANY FEE CHARGED BY THE BOARD OR THE DEPARTMENT FOR 6 7 PROVIDING RADIATION HEALTH SERVICES, INCLUDING THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS, NOT MORE THAN TWO TIMES 8 9 DURING THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2024, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, WITH THE 10 PERCENTAGE OF EACH INCREASE BEING NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE 11 PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF THE 12 INCREASE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 14 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-14-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 15 amended as follows:
- 16 45-14-31. (1) All initial application and registration fees
- 17 and annual fees due under this section shall be paid directly to
- 18 the agency for deposit into the Radiological Health Operations
- 19 Fund in the State Treasury. The Mississippi State Board of Health
- 20 shall submit its separate budget for carrying out the provisions
- 21 of this chapter. The budget shall be subject to and shall comply
- 22 with the requirements of the state budget law.

23 (2	) In	order	to	supplement	state	radiological	health	budget
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- 24 allocations authorized to carry out and enforce the provisions of
- 25 this chapter, the agency is authorized to charge and collect fees
- 26 for the following radiological health services:
- 27 \* \* \*
- 28 (a) Materials Licensing Fees: application fee and
- 29 annual fees shall be in congruence with and subject to 10 C.F.R.
- 30 170.21, 10 C.F.R. 170.31 and 10 C.F.R. 170.32; and
- 31 (b) Except as otherwise provided by law, the State
- 32 Board of Health or the State Department of Health may increase the
- 33 amount of any fee charged by the board or the department for
- 34 providing radiation health services, including the issuance and
- 35 renewal of licenses and registrations, not more than two (2) times
- 36 during the period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2028, with the
- 37 percentage of each increase being not more than twenty-five
- 38 percent (25%) of the amount of the fee in effect at the time of
- 39 the increase.
- The radiological health services that are included in each
- 41 specified category shall be determined by the agency by rules and
- 42 regulations adopted by the agency.

- 44 (3) The agency shall set the amount of the fees for all
- 45 other radiological health services not specified in subsection (2)
- 46 of this section, and any increase in the fees charged by the

- 47 agency under this subsection shall be in accordance with the
- 48 provisions of Section 41-3-65.
- 49 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2024.
