SENATE BILL NO. 2917 (As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO DEFINE THE AUTHORITY OF THE CAPITOL COMPLEX IMPROVEMENT 3 DISTRICT RELATIVE TO THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES, PROPERTY AND DEBRIS; TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-205, MISSISSIPPI CODE 4 OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND 5 6 ADMINISTRATION MAY PAY FOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FROM ANY FUNDS 7 APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 SECTION 1. Section 29-5-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 9 29-5-201. As used in Sections 29-5-201 through 29-5-217: 10 11 (a) "District" means the Capitol Complex Improvement 12 District. (b) "Improvement projects" means the following types of 13 projects in the public areas of the district: 14 15 (i) Street reconstruction, resurfacing and other 16 repairs to roadways, curbs and gutters; 17 (ii) Bridge construction, reconstruction and 18 repair;

No. 2917 G1/2 24/SS26/R1240PS PAGE 1 G1/2 19 (iii) Reconstructing and repairing of surface 20 water drainage systems including street drains, ditches, culverts and other components of the system; 21 22 (iv) Installing and replacing street lighting; 23 Installing and replacing traffic signals; (V) 24 (vi) Installation of new water and sewer lines and rehabilitation of existing water and sewer lines serving the 25 26 district, including those portions extending beyond the district 27 boundary required to perform the work; 28 (vii) Reconstruction and repair of parks and 29 public rights-of-way; 30 Reconstruction and repair of sidewalks (viii) 31 along public streets; 32 (ix) Planting and replacing landscaping materials, trees, and site amenities within public parks and rights-of-way; 33 34 (X) Relocation underground of power and 35 communication lines serving the district, including those portions extending beyond the district boundary required to perform the 36 37 work; * * * 38 Infrastructure, public safety, and other (xi) 39 improvements as determined necessary by the Executive Director of 40 the Department of Finance and Administration * * *; and 41 (xii) Demolition and removal of structures, 42 property and debris designated by the Capitol Complex Improvement 43 District Advisory Committee as slum or blight which constitute a S. 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44 nuisance to public health, safety and welfare, provided that

45 <u>private property owners receive due process within the meaning of</u> 46 state and federal law.

47 SECTION 2. Section 29-5-205, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 48 amended as follows:

49 29-5-205. (1) The Executive Director of the Department of 50 Finance and Administration or his or her designee shall implement, 51 supervise and administer improvement projects paid for with funds 52 from the Capitol Complex Improvement District Project Fund <u>or</u> 53 <u>other funds appropriated by the Legislature</u>, and may accept funds 54 and services from other sources to use for the purposes provided 55 in Sections 29-5-201 through 29-5-217.

Subject to the limitation on funds provided for in
Section 29-5-215, the executive director may employ persons as he
or she considers necessary for the proper implementation,
supervision and administration of improvement projects funded, in
whole or in part, by funds from the Capitol Complex Improvement
District Project Fund.

(3) Subject to the limitation on funds provided for in
Section 29-5-215, the Department of Finance and Administration
shall be reimbursed from the Capitol Complex Improvement District
Project Fund for the cost of providing necessary personnel,
services and other expenses it incurs in performing its duties
under Sections 29-5-201 through 29-5-217.

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68 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 69 and after July 1, 2024.
