SENATE BILL NO. 2981

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CLAIBORNE COUNTY FOR THE  
2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE COSTS OF CERTAIN INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS  
3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be  
6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General  
7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to Claiborne County for the  
8 purpose of defraying the costs of certain infrastructure projects  
9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30,  
10 2025.....\$ 3,560,000.00.

11 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of  
12 Section 1 of this act, the following amounts are to be allocated  
13 as follows:

14 To defray costs of repair,  
15 construction and resurfacing  
16 of certain roads and streets  
17 in the county, including  
18 Trace Hill, Karnac Ferry Road,



19 Hankinson Road, Willows Road  
 20 and Tillman Road.....\$1,100,000.00  
 21 To defray costs of implementing  
 22 the Claiborne County  
 23 Watershed-based Stormwater  
 24 Management Program.....\$250,000.00  
 25 To defray costs of renovating,  
 26 repairing and improving the  
 27 Claiborne County Library.....\$480,000.00  
 28 To defray costs of renovating,  
 29 repairing and improving the  
 30 county law enforcement  
 31 facilities.....\$230,000.00  
 32 To defray costs of designing,  
 33 renovating, improving,  
 34 constructing and equipping  
 35 recreational fields, courts  
 36 and playgrounds.....\$1,500,000.00

37 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid  
 38 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund  
 39 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State  
 40 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or  
 41 her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,  
 42 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.



43           **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
44 and after July 1, 2024.
