SENATE BILL NO. 3014 (As Sent to Governor)

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the University of Mississippi Medical
9	Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending
10	June 30, 2025\$ 193,774,571.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for
13	expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student
14	fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or
15	otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of the
16	University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
18	\$ 1,718,569,436.00.

- 19 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated and authorized for
- 20 expenditure under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this act,
- the University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the 21
- 22 School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of
- 23 Nursing, the School of Health Related Professions, the School of
- 24 Population Health, the Teaching Hospital and the Medical Center
- Service Area. The University of Mississippi Medical Center shall 25
- 26 prepare and make available to the Legislature an accounting of
- 27 expenditures for each of the divisions listed in this section at
- 28 the beginning of the legislative session.
- 29 SECTION 4. Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it
- 30 is the intention of the Legislature to enhance recognition of
- 31 excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting
- 32 qualified registered nurses.
- SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 33
- 34 act, and the funds authorized to be expended in Section 2 of this
- 35 act, none may be used to provide medical services on behalf of any
- state agency, institution or political subdivision, except to the 36
- 37 extent that such agency, institution or political subdivision
- 38 reimburses the hospital for the cost of the services provided.
- 39 Upon the rendering of medical services to any such agency,
- 40 institution or political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an
- invoice for the charges which shall be paid within ninety (90) 41
- 42 days. In the event that payment is not made within ninety (90)
- days, the hospital shall discontinue providing services to that 43

- 44 agency, institution or political subdivision until all outstanding
- 45 charges have been paid.
- SECTION 6. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 46
- paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 47
- 48 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
- 49 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 50 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 51 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for
- 52 Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 53
- 54 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2025
- 55 budget request process.
- 56 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 57 act, the following sums, or so much of those sums as may be
- 58 necessary, are derived out of any money in the State Treasury to
- 59 the credit of the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections
- 60 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, as follows:
- Education activities or scholarships \$ 6,888,029.00. 61 (a)
- 62 Rural Physicians Scholarship Program \$ 340,000.00. (b)
- \$ 63 Rural Dentists Scholarship Program (C) 105,000.00.
- 64 TOTAL....\$ 7,333,029.00.
- 65 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- Section 2 of this act, Two Million Three Hundred Eighty Thousand 66
- 67 Four Hundred Thirty-one Dollars (\$2,380,431.00) shall be derived
- from the Health Care Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407, 68

- 69 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the
- 70 University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- 71 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 72 of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty
- 73 Thousand Dollars (\$420,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships
- 74 for the Rural Dentists Scholarship Program as described in Section
- 75 37-146-1, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 76 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of
- 77 this act, Two Million One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars
- 78 (\$2,170,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural
- 79 Physicians Scholarship Program as described in Section 37-141-1,
- 80 Mississippi Code of 1972. Of this amount, Thirty-five Thousand
- 81 Dollars (\$35,000.00) is provided for a Psychiatrist Scholarship as
- 82 described in Section 37-144-3, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 83 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of
- 84 this act, Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-eight
- 85 Dollars (\$280,848.00) is provided for the administration of the
- 86 Rural Physicians Scholarship Program and the Rural Dentists
- 87 Scholarship Program.
- 88 **SECTION 13.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 89 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 90 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 91 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 92 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 93 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

- 94 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 95 made without competitive bids.
- 96 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, Four Million Seven Hundred Fifty 97 98 Thousand Dollars (\$4,750,000.00) shall be derived from the State 99 General Fund and Four Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 100 (\$4,250,000.00) shall be derived from any special source funds 101 collected by or otherwise become available for the support and 102 maintenance of the University of Mississippi Medical Center for 103 the University of Mississippi Medical Center Cancer Institute.
- SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this act, Five Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$595,000.00) is hereby appropriated for A Comprehensive Tobacco (ACT) Center at the University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- SECTION 16. None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized for expenditure under this act shall be used for research that kills or destroys an existing human embryo.
- SECTION 17. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 111 112 of Section 1 of this act, One Million Three Hundred Forty-nine 113 Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$1,349,998.00) shall 114 be provided from General Funds and shall be provided to the Center 115 of Excellence at the Blair E. Batson Hospital for Children for the care of abused and neglected children, and expended to improve, 116 117 enlarge and/or construct the physical facilities of the Children's Safe Center and for support and maintenance of the center. 118

- 119 **SECTION 18.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 120 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 121 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 122 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 123 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 124 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 125 actions contrary to this provision.
- 126 **SECTION 19.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- of Section 1 of this act, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00)
- 128 shall be provided to the MIND Center at the University of
- 129 Mississippi Medical Center.
- 130 **SECTION 20.** It is the intention of the Legislature that any
- 131 cash balances at the Office of Physician Workforce, the Children's
- 132 Safe Center, and the MIND Center shall only be spent in support of
- 133 those divisions.
- 134 **SECTION 21.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- act, One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00)
- 136 shall be provided for the Child Health and Developmental Promotion
- 137 (CHDP) Fellowship Program.
- 138 **SECTION 22.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 139 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital
- 140 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the University of
- 141 Mississippi Medical Center for the purpose of reauthorizing the
- 142 expenditure of Capital Expense Funds for the Asylum Hill Project,

143	as authorized in SB 3008, 2023 Regular Session, for the fiscal
144	year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
145	\$ 2,292,839.00.
146	Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
147	the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
148	section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds
149	remaining as of June 30, 2024, from the amount authorized for the
150	previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not
151	change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.
152	SECTION 23. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
153	of Section 2, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), or so
154	much thereof, shall be derived out of any money in the State
155	Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in
156	Section 27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, and allocated in a
157	manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office. These funds are
158	provided to create the Mississippi Rare Disease Advisory Council
159	as described in SB 2156, 2024 Regular Session.
160	SECTION 24. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
161	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
162	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
163	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
164	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
165	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
166	SECTION 25. This act shall take effect and be in force from
167	and after July 1, 2024.
