| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 6 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 7 | Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Massage Therapy Fund, |
| 8 | for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State |
| 9 | Board of Massage Therapy for the fiscal year beginning |

| 11 | SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the |
| 12 | Board of Massage Therapy shall maintain complete accounting and |
| 13 | personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds |
| 14 | appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the |
| 15 | same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year |
| 16 | 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the |
| 17 | agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to |

the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

- 21 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 22 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 23 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 24 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 25 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 26 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 27 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 28 made without competitive bids.
- 29 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
- 31 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
- 32 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
- 33 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
- 34 in the manner provided by law.
