SENATE BILL NO. 3060

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 951, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2023,  
 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF RANKIN COUNTY,  
 3 MISSISSIPPI, AND THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF PEARL,  
 4 MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,500,000.00  
 5 IN THE AGGREGATE ANNUALLY TO TRUSTMARK PARK; TO AMEND CHAPTER 952,  
 6 LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2023, WHICH AUTHORIZES THE CITY OF PEARL  
 7 TO CONTRIBUTE AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000.00 TO TRUSTMARK  
 8 PARK, TO CHANGE THE DATE OF THE CHAPTER'S REPEAL TO THE EFFECTIVE  
 9 DATE OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 951, Local and Private Laws of 2023, is  
 12 amended as follows:

13 Section 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Rankin County,  
 14 Mississippi, and the governing authorities of the City of Pearl,  
 15 Mississippi, \* \* \* are authorized and empowered, in \* \* \* their  
 16 discretion, to contribute an amount not to exceed \* \* \* One  
 17 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) in the  
 18 aggregate annually from available county and municipal funds to  
 19 the athletic facility known as Trustmark Park, a Minor League  
 20 Baseball stadium which is located within the city and county and



21 which provides economic development and tourism benefits to the  
22 city and county.

23 (2) This section shall be repealed from and after December  
24 31, 2035.

25 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 952, Local and Private Laws of 2023, is  
26 amended as follows:

27 (1) The governing authorities of the City of Pearl,  
28 Mississippi, are authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to  
29 contribute an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand  
30 Dollars (\$750,000.00) from available municipal funds to the  
31 athletic facility known as Trustmark Park, a Minor League Baseball  
32 stadium which is located within the city and which provides  
33 economic development and tourism benefits to the city.

34 (2) This section shall be repealed from and after \* \* \* the  
35 effective date of Senate Bill No. 3060, 2024 Regular Session.

36 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
37 and after its passage.
