SENATE BILL NO. 3061

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARSHALL
2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO EMPLOY SUCH ADDITIONAL PART-TIME COUNTY
3 PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS AS IT DETERMINES NECESSARY; AND FOR RELATED
4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
7 Mississippi, may, in its discretion, employ such additional
8 part-time assistant county prosecuting attorneys as it determines
9 necessary, designate the duties and responsibilities of such
10 assistant county prosecuting attorneys, and pay such assistant
11 county prosecuting attorneys an annual salary in an amount as
12 determined by the board of supervisors; however, the annual salary
13 of assistant county prosecuting attorneys employed under this
14 section shall not exceed ninety percent (90%) of the salary paid
15 to the elected County Prosecuting Attorney of Marshall County.
16 The salary authorized by this section for assistant prosecuting
17 attorneys shall be the sole and complete salary to be paid by
18 Marshall County for such assistant county prosecuting attorneys in



19 Marshall County, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
20 contrary.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after its passage.
