6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the General
8	Fund not otherwise appropriated to the Town of Duck Hill,
9	Mississippi, for the purpose of defraying costs associated with
10	certain infrastructure projects for the fiscal year beginning July
11	1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025\$ 9,015,000.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under Section 1, the
13	following amounts are to be allocated as follows:
14	To defray the costs of improvements, construction, and
15	re-surfacing of Main Street from State Highway 51 to State Highway
16	404 West\$ 1,400,000.00
17	To defray the costs of improvements, construction, and
18	re-surfacing of Rosemont Street from Carrollton Street to Duck
19	Hill Cemetery\$ 1,100,000.00
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20	To defray the costs of the construction of
21	Lancaster Circle\$ 1,200,000.00
22	To defray the costs of improvements, construction, and
23	re-surfacing of Martin Luther King Street\$ 1,325,000.00
24	To defray the costs of improvements, construction, and
25	re-surfacing of Wilson Street from South Binford Avenue to State
26	Highway 51\$ 1,400,000.00
27	To defray the costs of purchasing and installing ten (10)
28	speed bumps\$ 45,000.00
29	To defray the costs of purchasing and installing standby
30	generators at each municipal well\$ 220,000.00
31	To defray the costs of repairing and painting elevated water
32	storage tank\$ 750,000.00
33	To defray the costs of constructing a
34	helipad\$ 75,000.00
35	To defray the costs of gas line service in Grenada
36	County\$ 750,000.00
37	To defray the costs of the eater valve infrastructure
38	project\$ 750,000.00
39	SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
40	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the General Fund not
41	otherwise appropriated upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
42	Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
43	upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
44	in the manner provided by law.
