SENATE BILL NO. 3103

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER LAW 925, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF
 2 2020, TO EXTEND THE DATE OF REPEAL TO JULY 1, 2028, ON THE LAW
 3 THAT AUTHORIZES THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LAUDERDALE COUNTY,
 4 MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER
 5 ASSESSMENTS AND COURT COSTS, FOR CIVIL CASES FILED AND MISDEMEANOR
 6 CONVICTIONS AND/OR NONADJUDICATIONS OBTAINED IN ITS JUSTICE COURT,
 7 TO BE USED TO FUND THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, FURNISHING,
 8 TECHNOLOGY, MAINTENANCE AND RELATED NEEDS OF A NEW COUNTY OFFICE
 9 BUILDING TO BE KNOWN AS THE "LAUDERDALE COUNTY GOVERNMENT
 10 COMPLEX"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

12 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 925, Local and Private Laws of 2020, is
 13 amended as follows:

14 (1) The Board of Supervisors of Lauderdale County,
 15 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized, by resolution duly
 16 adopted, to levy an assessment, in addition to any other
 17 assessments and court costs in the Justice Court of Lauderdale
 18 County, as follows:

19 (a) An amount not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) on
 20 each conviction or nonadjudication under the Mississippi Implied
 21 Consent Law; and



22 (b) An amount not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars
23 (\$25.00) on each misdemeanor conviction or nonadjudication other
24 than those specified in paragraph (a) of this subsection, and on
25 each civil case filed.

26 (2) The avails of the additional assessment imposed under
27 subsection (1) of this section shall be expended by the Board of
28 Supervisors of Lauderdale County to fund the construction,
29 operation, furnishing, technology, maintenance and related needs
30 of a new county office building, to be known as the "Lauderdale
31 County Government Complex."

32 (3) This section shall be repealed from and after July
33 1, * * * 2028.

34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
35 and after its passage.
