## SENATE BILL NO. 3103 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER LAW 925, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2020, TO EXTEND THE DATE OF REPEAL TO JULY 1, 2028, ON THE LAW 3 THAT AUTHORIZES THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LAUDERDALE COUNTY, 4 MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER 5 ASSESSMENTS AND COURT COSTS, FOR MISDEMEANOR CONVICTIONS AND/OR 6 NONADJUDICATIONS OBTAINED IN ITS JUSTICE COURT, TO BE USED TO FUND 7 THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, FURNISHING, TECHNOLOGY, MAINTENANCE 8 AND RELATED NEEDS OF A NEW COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING TO BE KNOWN AS 9 THE "LAUDERDALE COUNTY GOVERNMENT COMPLEX"; TO REMOVE CIVIL CASES 10 FROM THE ASSESSMENT AUTHORIZATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 925, Local and Private Laws of 2020, is
- 13 amended as follows:
- 14 (1) The Board of Supervisors of Lauderdale County,
- 15 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized, by resolution duly
- 16 adopted, to levy an assessment, in addition to any other
- 17 assessments and court costs in the Justice Court of Lauderdale
- 18 County, as follows:
- 19 (a) An amount not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) on
- 20 each conviction or nonadjudication under the Mississippi Implied
- 21 Consent Law; and

22 (b) An amount not to exceed Twenty-five Dolla	ars

- 23 (\$25.00) on each misdemeanor conviction or nonadjudication other
- 24 than those specified in paragraph (a) of this subsection  $\star \star \star$ .
- 25 (2) The avails of the additional assessment imposed under
- 26 subsection (1) of this section shall be expended by the Board of
- 27 Supervisors of Lauderdale County to fund the construction,
- 28 operation, furnishing, technology, maintenance and related needs
- 29 of a new county office building, to be known as the "Lauderdale
- 30 County Government Complex."
- 31 (3) This section shall be repealed from and after July
