7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
9	necessary, is appropriated out of any money not otherwise
LO	appropriated to the credit of the Coronavirus State Fiscal
L1	Recovery Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
L2	Treasurer's Office, to the Department of Finance and
L3	Administration Bureau of Building, Grounds, and Real Property

L7	This additional appropriation under this section is for the

- 22 in conformity therewith.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** "Capital projects" for the purpose of this act
- 24 shall mean the following:
- 25 (a) Eligible projects under the Environmental Protection
- 26 Agency's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) or Drinking
- 27 Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF), lead remediation, and
- 28 stormwater infrastructure;
- 29 b) Prevention, mitigation, or other services in congregate
- 30 living facilities and other key settings;
- 31 (c) Ventilation system installation and improvements;
- 32 (d) Capital investments in public facilities to implement
- 33 COVID-19 mitigation tactics;
- 34 (e) Improvements to state parks due to increased use;
- 35 (f) Any other eligible project through ARPA guidelines,
- 36 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be
- 37 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the
- 38 Treasury, excluding broadband infrastructure.
- 39 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 40 Department of Finance and Administration Bureau of Building,
- 41 Grounds, and Real Property Management prioritize necessary
- 42 investment in drinking water, wastewater, and stormwater
- 43 infrastructure when determining projects unless the entity
- 44 operates a congregate living facility or the purpose is expressly
- 45 stated in this act.

- SECTION 4. None of the funds appropriated under this act
- 47 shall be used to pay employee premium payments.
- 48 **SECTION 5.** (1) As used in this section and Section 6 of
- 49 this act, the term "department" means the Department of Finance
- 50 and Administration Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property
- 51 Management.
- 52 (2) The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated
- 53 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an
- 54 individualized determination that the expenditure sought is, in
- 55 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures
- 56 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as
- 57 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 58 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules,
- 59 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or
- 60 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of
- 61 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not
- 62 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in
- 63 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds,
- 64 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal
- 65 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In
- 66 addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated
- 67 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit
- 68 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the
- 69 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal
- 70 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding subrecipient

- 71 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 72 requirements.
- 73 As a condition of receiving and expending (1)74 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 75 department shall certify that each expenditure of the funds 76 appropriated to the department under this act complies with the 77 guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 78 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 79 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 80 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.
- 81 (2) If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 82 83 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 84 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended 85 86 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 87 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 88 89 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 90 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 91 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA; and (b) the State 92 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 93 94 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or 95

SECTION 7. The department shall submit to the Joint
Legislative Budget Committee by October 1 of each year an annual
report. The reports shall contain a listing of the projects
intended to be funded through this appropriation, the amount of
funds allocated toward each project, the amount of funds expended
on each project, and the status of each project.

SECTION 8. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and shall stand repealed on the day before its passage.
