## SENATE BILL NO. 3222

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO ROBERT MAXWELL OF OKTIBBEHA COUNTY.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Robert Maxwell of Oktibbeha County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on October 19, 1981, in Oktibbeha County on the charge
- 8 of embezzlement, for which he was sentenced to serve thirty-six
- 9 (36) months under the supervision of the Mississippi Department of
- 10 Corrections on probation.
- On January 24, 1996, he was convicted in Oktibbeha County on
- 12 the charge of embezzlement for which he was sentenced to serve two
- 13 (2) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 14 Corrections. He was paroled on February 2, 1997.
- The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 16 himself as a law-abiding citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after its passage.
