SENATE BILL NO. 3223

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DEWITT COOPERWOOD OF OKTIBBEHA COUNTY.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to DeWitt Cooperwood of Oktibbeha County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on October 18, 1993, in Oktibbeha County on the charge
- 8 of false pretenses-communications cross jurisdictional lines, for
- 9 which he was sentenced to serve three (3) years in the custody of
- 10 the Mississippi Department of Corrections. On November 3, 1994,
- 11 he was discharged to the supervision of Mississippi Probation and
- 12 Parole Board.
- 13 The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 14 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 15 lawful manner.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
