SENATE BILL NO. 3227

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO TEDDY NULL OF ALCORN COUNTY.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Teddy Cleveland Null of Alcorn County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on October 9, 1995, in Alcorn County on the charge of
- 8 receiving stolen property, for which he was sentenced to serve
- 9 five (5) years under the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 10 Corrections on probation. He was released to parole on March 2,
- 11 1996, and was discharged on June 1, 1998.
- On August 2, 2002, he was convicted in Alcorn County on the
- 13 charges of receiving stolen property, operating chop shop,
- 14 possession of stolen or altered vehicle parts, and
- 15 burglary-residential for which the longest sentence he received
- 16 was fifteen (15) years in the custody of the Mississippi
- 17 Department of Corrections with five (5) years suspended. He was

- 18 released to earned release supervision on November 9, 2006, and
- 19 discharged on May 6, 2010.
- 20 On December 7, 2016, he was convicted in Alcorn County on the
- 21 charges of conspiracy to commit a crime and false statement for
- 22 which he was sentenced to serve one (1) year on house arrest under
- 23 the supervision of the Mississippi Department of Corrections and
- 24 five (5) years with intensive supervision. He was released to
- 25 parole on July 31, 2017, and discharged on October 10, 2017.
- The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 27 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 28 lawful manner.
- 29 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 30 and after its passage.
