SENATE BILL NO. 3228

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO KENNETH EDWARD
2 BARNES OF WALTHALL COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Kenneth Edward Barnes of Walthall County,
6 Mississippi, who, upon representation, was disqualified as an
7 elector in 1977, in Walthall County for conviction of the crime of
8 grand larceny, for which he was sentenced to serve a term of years
9 within the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.

10 The Legislature is informed that he has since his release
11 from incarceration conducted himself as a law-abiding and
12 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
14 and after its passage.
