SENATE BILL NO. 3228  
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO KENNETH EDWARD  
2 BARNES OF WALTHALL COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Kenneth Edward Barnes of Walthall County,  
6 Mississippi, who, upon representation, was disqualified as an  
7 elector in 1977, in Walthall County for conviction of the crime of  
8 grand larceny, for which he was sentenced to serve a term of years  
9 within the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections  
10 and was subsequently released and discharged.

11 The Legislature is informed that since his release from  
12 incarceration he has conducted himself as a law-abiding and  
13 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
15 and after its passage.
