SENATE BILL NO. 3229

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO STANLEY BARNES, OF  
2 CLAIBORNE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Stanley Barnes, of Claiborne County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction in 1990 of the crime of murder in Claiborne County,  
8 Mississippi, and who was sentenced to life in the custody of the  
9 Department of Corrections. He was paroled on September 13, 2000,  
10 and remains on unsupervised parole. The Legislature is informed  
11 that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable  
12 citizen in a good and lawful manner.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
14 and after its passage.
