SENATE BILL NO. 3230

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 916, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2016, 2 AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 935, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2020, TO 3 EXTEND THE REPEAL DATE FROM JULY 1, 2024, TO JULY 1, 2028, ON THE 4 PROVISION OF LAW AUTHORIZING THE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS OF ALCORN, 5 BENTON, PRENTISS, TIPPAH AND TISHOMINGO COUNTIES TO CONTRIBUTE TO 6 NORTHEAST MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC., IN AN AMOUNT 7 DETERMINED BY EACH INDIVIDUAL BOARD NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.00, TO BE USED AS MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT; TO 8 9 EXTEND THE SAME AUTHORITY TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARSHALL 10 COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Chapter 916, Local and Private Laws of 2016, as amended by Chapter 935, Local and Private Laws of 2020, is amended as follows:

15 Section 1. (1) The Boards of Supervisors of Alcorn, Benton, 16 Marshall, Prentiss, Tippah and Tishomingo Counties, Mississippi, 17 are authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to contribute to Northeast Mississippi Community Services, Inc., a community 18 19 action agency, a sum in an amount determined by each individual 20 board provided that the amount does not exceed One Hundred Fifty 21 Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from each individual board to be 22 used as matching funds in order that Northeast Mississippi S. 23 Community Services, Inc., may receive funds from the state or 24 federal government.

(2) The provisions of this section shall be repealed from
and after July 1, * * 2028.
