SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 513

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 241 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO LIMIT VOTING IN STATE AND LOCAL ELECTIONS TO CITIZENS OF MISSISSIPPI.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 5 MISSISSIPPI, TWO-THIRDS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 6 CONCURRING THEREIN, WHICH TWO-THIRDS CONSISTS OF NOT LESS THAN A
- 7 MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE, That the following
- 8 amendment to the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 is proposed to
- 9 the qualified electors of the state:
- 10 Amend Section 241, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 Section 241. * * * Only an inhabitant of this state, except
- 13 idiots and insane persons, who is a citizen of the United States
- 14 of America, eighteen (18) years old and upward, who has been a
- 15 resident of this state for one (1) year, and for one (1) year in
- 16 the county in which he offers to vote, and for six (6) months in
- 17 the election precinct or in the incorporated city or town in which
- 18 he offers to vote, and who is duly registered as provided in this

- 19 article, and who has never been convicted of murder, rape,
- 20 bribery, theft, arson, obtaining money or goods under false
- 21 pretense, perjury, forgery, embezzlement or bigamy, is declared to
- 22 be a qualified elector, except that he shall be qualified to vote
- 23 for President and Vice President of the United States if he meets
- 24 the requirements established by Congress therefor and is otherwise
- 25 a qualified elector.
- 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the amendment in this resolution
- 27 shall be submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified
- 28 electors at an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the
- 29 first Monday of November 2024, as provided by Section 273 of the
- 30 Constitution and by general law.
- 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of the amendment
- 32 for the ballot shall read as follows: "The current language of
- 33 the Mississippi Constitution leaves an opportunity for noncitizen
- 34 inhabitants of Mississippi to vote in local and state elections.
- 35 By amending the Constitution's language as proposed, eligible

- 36 voters in local and state elections would be limited to citizens
- 37 of Mississippi."
