SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 546

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING APRIL 11, 2024, AS "REMAN
2 DAY" IN MISSISSIPPI.

3 WHEREAS, remanufacturing is a comprehensive and rigorous
4 industrial process by which a previously sold, leased, used, worn,
5 remanufactured or nonfunctional product or part is returned to a
6 like-new, same-as-when-new, or better-than-when-new condition,
7 from both a quality and performance perspective, through a
8 controlled, reproducible and sustainable process; and

9 WHEREAS, a 2012 United States International Trade Commission
10 (ITC) report found that remanufacturers support at least 180,000
11 full-time jobs in the United States. Further, the ITC report
12 states that production of remanufactured goods in the United
13 States increased by 15% from 2009 to 2011, and exports totaled
14 \$11.2 Billion annually; and

15 WHEREAS, remanufacturing has been recognized by leading
16 universities, research institutions and manufacturers in the
17 United States as good for the environment for its ability to
18 divert end-of-life products from landfills; and



19 WHEREAS, by encouraging businesses, state agencies, nonprofit
20 organizations, schools and individuals to celebrate "Reman Day" in
21 Mississippi on April 11, 2024, we can further promote
22 remanufacturing as environmentally friendly and economically
23 smart; and

24 WHEREAS, to focus the nation's attention on the benefits of
25 remanufacturing, our state's businesses, educational institutions
26 and nonprofit organizations have joined together to celebrate
27 "Reman Day" in Mississippi and are encouraging colleagues,
28 friends, families and local communities to learn more about the
29 benefits of remanufactured products:

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
31 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
32 we do hereby designate April 11, 2024, as "Reman Day" in
33 Mississippi.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
35 the Mississippi Manufacturers Association for appropriate
36 distribution and be made available to the Capitol Press Corps.
