## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 548

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES AND OTHER  
2 PROVISIONS IMPOSED BY JOINT RULE NO. 40 FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE  
3 DRAFTING, INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF A BILL  
4 ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-11-123, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF  
5 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE INCREASE IN THE EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION  
6 RATE THAT IS SCHEDULED TO TAKE EFFECT ON JULY 1, 2024, IS  
7 RESCINDED AND SHALL NOT TAKE EFFECT; TO PROVIDE FOR A 1/2%  
8 INCREASE IN THE EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION RATE ON JULY 1 OF EACH  
9 YEAR FROM 2024 THROUGH 2028; TO REQUIRE THAT ANY RECOMMENDATION BY  
10 THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM  
11 TO ADJUST EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS BE ACCOMPANIED BY AT LEAST TWO  
12 INDEPENDENT ACTUARIAL ASSESSMENTS; TO ALLOW THE BOARD TO MAKE  
13 RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING SOURCES FOR THE  
14 RETIREMENT PLAN, INCLUDING EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION INCREASES, BASED  
15 ON THE PLAN'S ASSETS AND LIABILITIES, AND THE REQUIRED ACTUARIAL  
16 ASSESSMENTS; TO RESERVE TO THE LEGISLATURE THE AUTHORITY TO  
17 IMPLEMENT SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS; TO EXPRESS THE INTENT OF THE  
18 LEGISLATURE THAT, IN THE 2025 REGULAR SESSION, A LAW BE ENACTED TO  
19 CREATE A NEW TIER FOR FUTURE MEMBERS OF THE SYSTEM, IN FURTHERANCE  
20 OF THE SYSTEM'S CONTINUED FINANCIAL STABILITY AND SUSTAINABILITY;  
21 TO SPECIFY THAT THE SECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROVIDE  
22 AUTHORITY TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE ANY EARNED BENEFITS PROVIDED BY  
23 THE STATE TO CURRENT RETIREES OR CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE RETIREMENT  
24 SYSTEM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES," AND OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT  
25 RELATING TO THE FUNDING OF PUBLIC EDUCATION IN THE STATE OF  
26 MISSISSIPPI; TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-151-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF  
27 1972, TO DEFINE CERTAIN TERMS, INCLUDING 'NET ENROLLMENT,' 'TOTAL  
28 FUNDING FORMULA' AND 'WEIGHT'; TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-151-203,  
29 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT EFFECTIVE FISCAL YEAR  
30 2026 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL  
31 PROVIDE A PROPOSED BASE-STUDENT COST SUFFICIENT TO PROVIDE CERTAIN  
32 COST COMPONENTS OF EDUCATING PUPILS IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS; TO  
33 PROVIDE THAT THE INSTRUCTIONAL COST SHALL BE CALCULATED BY  
34 DIVIDING THE AVERAGE TEACHER SALARY BY THE STUDENT-TO-TEACHER



35 RATIO; TO PROVIDE THE FORMULA FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COST, ANCILLARY  
36 PERSONNEL AND EXPENSES, AND OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PLANT; TO  
37 CREATE NEW SECTION 37-151-205, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
38 ESTABLISH VARIOUS WEIGHTS TO BE APPLIED TO THE BASE AMOUNT FOR  
39 STUDENTS WHO ARE LOW-INCOME STUDENTS, ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS,  
40 ELIGIBLE FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES, GIFTED, ENROLLED IN  
41 CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION, AND RESIDING IN SPARSELY POPULATED  
42 SCHOOL DISTRICTS; TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-151-207, MISSISSIPPI  
43 CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE STUDENT ENROLLMENT AND ATTENDANCE FIGURES  
44 TO BE DETERMINED ON THE BASIS OF NET ENROLLMENT; TO CREATE NEW  
45 SECTION 37-151-209, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THAT A  
46 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL HAS AUTONOMY, SUBJECT TO  
47 REGULATORY AND STATUTORY RESTRICTIONS, IN THE SPENDING OF ALL  
48 FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THAT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL; TO  
49 CREATE NEW SECTION 37-151-211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
50 REQUIRE TAX ASSESSORS TO FILE CERTAIN REPORTS WITH THE STATE  
51 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO CALCULATE  
52 THE DISTRICT'S REQUIRED MINIMUM MILLAGE AND THE CONTRIBUTION TO  
53 THE COST OF THE TOTAL FUNDING FORMULA REQUIRED OF EACH SCHOOL  
54 DISTRICT AND CHARTER SCHOOL; TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-151-213,  
55 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE'S SHARE IN  
56 SUPPORT OF THE FUNDING FORMULA FOR A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER  
57 SCHOOL FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025, 2026, AND 2027 MAY NOT BE LESS THAN  
58 AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE SUM OF ALL STATE FUNDS RECEIVED BY THAT  
59 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; TO AMEND  
60 SECTIONS 37-57-1, 37-57-104, 37-57-105 AND 37-57-107, MISSISSIPPI  
61 CODE OF 1972, WHICH RELATE TO SCHOOL DISTRICT TAXATION, IN  
62 CONFORMITY TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; TO AMEND SECTION  
63 37-61-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT  
64 A PORTION OF EDUCATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS BE DISTRIBUTED TO SCHOOL

99 RATING OR HIGHER FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE YEARS; TO REPEAL SECTIONS

117 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE  
118 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That all of the  
119 deadlines and other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40 are  
120 suspended for the purpose of the drafting, introduction,  
121 consideration and passage of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND  
122 SECTION 25-11-123, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE  
123 INCREASE IN THE EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION RATE THAT IS SCHEDULED TO  
124 TAKE EFFECT ON JULY 1, 2024, IS RESCINDED AND SHALL NOT TAKE  
125 EFFECT; TO PROVIDE FOR A 1/2% INCREASE IN THE EMPLOYER'S  
126 CONTRIBUTION RATE ON JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR FROM 2024 THROUGH 2028;



127 TO REQUIRE THAT ANY RECOMMENDATION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
128 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO ADJUST EMPLOYER  
129 CONTRIBUTIONS BE ACCOMPANIED BY AT LEAST TWO INDEPENDENT ACTUARIAL  
130 ASSESSMENTS; TO ALLOW THE BOARD TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING  
131 ADDITIONAL FUNDING SOURCES FOR THE RETIREMENT PLAN, INCLUDING  
132 EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION INCREASES, BASED ON THE PLAN'S ASSETS AND  
133 LIABILITIES, AND THE REQUIRED ACTUARIAL ASSESSMENTS; TO RESERVE TO  
134 THE LEGISLATURE THE AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS;  
135 TO EXPRESS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT, IN THE 2025 REGULAR  
136 SESSION, A LAW BE ENACTED TO CREATE A NEW TIER FOR FUTURE MEMBERS  
137 OF THE SYSTEM, IN FURTHERANCE OF THE SYSTEM'S CONTINUED FINANCIAL  
138 STABILITY AND SUSTAINABILITY; TO SPECIFY THAT THE SECTION SHALL  
139 NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE ANY
