5	WHEREAS, even though the score was tied 0-0 through most of
6	the first half, the outcome never seemed in doubt; and
7	WHEREAS, the Jackson Prep "Patriots" Boys won the MAIS
8	Division I Class 6A State Soccer Championship in dominating
9	fashion over the Presbyterian Christian School (PCS) "Bobcats" on
10	February 15, 2024, shutting out the visitors 3-0; and
11	WHEREAS, Prep applied the pressure from start to finish,
12	using tremendous footwork and passing skills to keep the ball on
13	the "Bobcats'" end of the field and PCS defenders on edge. With
14	10 minutes to play before the break, the "Patriots'" Austin Craft
15	nailed a penalty kick past the "Bobcats'" goalkeeper, and fans
16	seemed to hear the nail driving through the coffin; and
17	WHEREAS, "Austin is a senior, he is our goal-scorer, and
18	everything goes through him," Prep Coach Jon Marcus Duncan said
19	afterward. "He's had an unbelievable career. All of these

- 20 seniors, they're big brothers to these younger guys. What a
- 21 finish for them"; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Austin Craft sailed his penalty kick high and left
- 23 into the net just outside of PCS's reach, and the excitement along
- 24 the Prep sideline and in the stands was huge; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the "Patriots," who played with ease on offense and
- 26 with serious intent on defense, earned more breathing room with
- 27 16:10 to play when senior Warner Russ put a short kick past the
- 28 overworked PCS. Holding a 2-0 lead with most of the second half
- 29 remaining, the celebration was officially on. "This was a
- 30 complete team effort," Coach Duncan said. "We played great in the
- 31 back, I thought we controlled the middle, and our guys up front
- 32 worked so hard to create some goals"; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Sophomore Jetson Hollingsworth put the icing on the
- 34 cake with a goal from the right corner with 2:00 left, giving
- 35 Coach Duncan his 29th career State Soccer Title at Prep, 15 with
- 36 the boys' teams and 14 with the "Lady Patriots"; and
