SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 56

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE EAST RANKIN
2 ACADEMY "LADY PATRIOTS" GIRLS CROSS COUNTRY TEAM AND COACH DAVID
3 HOPPER FOR WINNING THEIR THIRD CONSECUTIVE MAIS CLASS 5A STATE
4 CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, we join the students, faculty and parents of East
6 Rankin Academy in celebrating the third consecutive State
7 Championship by the "Lady Patriots" Girls Cross Country Team; and

8 WHEREAS, the East Rankin Academy (ERA) Patriot Cross Country
9 Team concluded their 2023 regular season on Monday, October 23rd.
10 The "Lady Patriots," entering the season as the No. 1 ranked team
11 in the state, defended their MAIS 5A State Championship for a
12 third consecutive year. The varsity girls' team, led by junior,
13 Audrey Mayatte, defeated runner-up, Simpson Academy by two points.
14 The scoring five "Lady Patriots" included Audrey Mayatte; eighth
15 grader, Emma Raines; sixth grader, Jewel Baker; sophomore, Jensen
16 Baker; and sophomore, Emily Williams; and

17 WHEREAS, the 2023 season kicked off with the "Lady Patriots"
18 Varsity Cross Country Team winning the season opener at the
19 Simpson Academy Early Bird. This success would set the stage for



20 the "Lady Patriots'" winning seven of their ten season matchups,
21 including the Park Place Invitational, the Jackson Victors
22 Kickoff, the Forerunners Night Run, the MRA Invitational and the
23 Clinton Arrow Invitational; and

24 WHEREAS, as finalists in the top ten of the varsity 5K races,
25 three "Lady Patriots" were named to the MAIS 5A All-State Team to
26 include sophomore, Audrey Mayatte; eighth grader, Emma Raines; and
27 sixth grader, Jewel Baker; and

28 WHEREAS, the 2023 ERA Team, coached by Coach David Hopper,
29 concluded the season with the varsity "Lady Patriots" ranked First
30 in MAIS 5A and Second in the MAIS overall; and

31 WHEREAS, the East Rankin Academy "Lady Patriots" Girls Cross
