SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 83

1 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING CHARLIE FRUGÉ OF OXFORD,
2 MISSISSIPPI, FOR WINNING THE STUDENT NOMINATION TO THE STATE BOARD
3 OF EDUCATION BASED ON THE COMPETITIVE PROCESS AND COMMENDING HIS
4 ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS.

5 WHEREAS, the Mississippi State Board of Education selected
6 Charlie Frugé through a competitive process as the student
7 representative to the Board to serve a two-year term from June
8 2022 to April 2024; and

9 WHEREAS, Charlie exemplified educational excellence by
10 maintaining a 4.32 weighted grade point average at Oxford High
11 School in the Oxford School District; and

12 WHEREAS, he helped advance educational policy as founder and
13 president of Frugé Tutoring, which since Summer 2020 has provided
14 more than 300 hours of free tutoring in Algebra, Geometry,
15 English, Biology, Chemistry and ACT Prep; and

16 WHEREAS, Charlie became active in several student, community,
17 state and national organizations, including as Class President
18 during his freshman, sophomore and junior years; Student Body
19 President his senior year; Vice President of Oxford High School



20 Students for Alzheimer's Awareness; Co-president of Fellowship of
21 Christian Athletes; Co-founder and Co-president of History Bowl;
22 Student Section Leader of OZONE; Captain of OHS Tennis; member of
23 OHS Cross Country team; Mississippi Governor's School Class
24 Chairman; delegate in American Legion Boys State; Governor in Boys
25 State; Eagle Scout; and as a U.S. Senate Page; and

26 WHEREAS, Charlie earned numerous honors and awards, including
27 National Merit Scholarship semi-finalist; U.S. Senate Page School
28 English Award; OHS AP Government Award; DECA State Finance
29 Champion; OHS Honors Chemistry Award; OHS Pre-AP History Award;
30 induction into the Order of the Arrow, a National Honor Society of
31 Boy Scouts; and

32 WHEREAS, he led his peers statewide as the co-leader of the
33 State Superintendent of Education Student Advisory Council; and

34 WHEREAS, Charlie has brought his experiences as a student in
35 the classroom and commitment to his role on the Mississippi State
36 Board of Education to make sure Mississippi's public schools are
37 always improving and children are receiving the education they
38 deserve; and

39 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we commend a young
40 Mississippi citizen who has brought honor to his school and
41 community and represents the future of the State of Mississippi:
