SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 90

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE NORTHWEST
2 MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE "RANGERS" CHEER TEAM FOR WINNING THE
3 2024 UCA AND UDA COLLEGE CHEERLEADING NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP, OPEN
4 ALL-GIRL DIVISION.

5 WHEREAS, with the word "magical" often used to describe Walt
6 Disney World Resort, it was only fitting for the Northwest
7 Mississippi Community College "Rangers" Cheer Team to experience a
8 magical weekend of their own on January 12 through 14, 2024, with
9 the team taking home a UCA and UDA College Cheerleading National
10 Championship win in the Open All-Girl division, at the ESPN Wide
11 World of Sports Complex at the Walt Disney World Resort in
12 Florida; and

13 WHEREAS, over 300 universities from across 48 states were
14 present for the competition, and cheerleading teams were judged on
15 their stunting and tumbling skills, crowd-leading ability and
16 overall performance; and

17 WHEREAS, since the 2020-2021 season, the "Rangers" have
18 earned four national titles, and this year, the team competed in
19 three divisions and took home top finishes in all three, with



20 their most notable victory being in the Open All-Girl division,
21 collecting a first place finish in the semifinals with an 87.9
22 score, before earning a winning 90.8 total in the finals; and

23 WHEREAS, the "Rangers" have been superbly coached and
24 tremendously inspired by Head Coach Brandon Casey and Assistant
25 Coach Rainy Bordelon; and

26 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize these
27 outstanding Mississippi student-athletes, whose hard work and
28 dedication bring honor to Northwest Mississippi Community College
29 and to the State of Mississippi:

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
31 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate the
32 Northwest Mississippi Community College "Rangers" Cheer Team for
33 winning the 2024 UCA and UDA College Cheerleading National
34 Championship, Open All-Girl Division and extend to them best
35 wishes for continued success in all their future endeavors.
