- A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE 90TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION AND FOURTH-GENERATION LEGACY OF F.E.B. DISTRIBUTING AND CAPITAL CITY BEVERAGES COMPANY.
- WHEREAS, we join the Central Mississippi business community
- 5 and citizens in recognizing the anniversary of a world-class
- 6 business; and
- WHEREAS, in February 1934, Salvador J. Bertucci, operating
- 8 out of Gulfport, Mississippi, founded the S.J. Bertucci Company,
- 9 now known as F.E.B. Distributing Company, Inc. The brands
- 10 distributed at that time originated from the New Orleans area,
- 11 where approximately 10 brewers were in operation. The company was
- 12 appointed the distributor for the Mississippi Gulf Coast for JAX
- 13 beer that same year; and
- 14 WHEREAS, later in 1941, Salvador J. Bertucci opened a company
- 15 in Jackson, distributing brands to the Central Mississippi
- 16 territory in what is now known as Capital City Beverages; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in 1946, Salvador J. Bertucci's son, Frank E.
- 18 Bertucci, joined the company, hence the name being changed to

- 19 F.E.B. Distributing Company. In the 1960s, F.E.B. Distributing
- 20 Company was appointed the exclusive distributor for the Miller
- 21 Brewing Company, as well as acquired imported Heineken for the
- 22 Mississippi Gulf Coast; and
- 23 WHEREAS, as the years passed, the third generation of the
- 24 family joined the business as S.J.'s grandsons and brothers, Frank
- 25 and Paul Bertucci, started leading F.E.B. Distributing on the
- 26 Mississippi Gulf Coast; and
- 27 WHEREAS, in 2000, F.E.B. Distributing was relocated to its
- 28 final and newly built home, a state-of-the-art office, warehouse,
- 29 and vehicle maintenance facility in the Light Industrial Park of
- 30 the Seaway Industrial Park in Gulfport, Mississippi; and
- 31 WHEREAS, F.E.B. Distributing and Capital City Beverages are
- 32 now employed and run by the fourth generation of the family; they
- 33 have worked for 90 years as family owned and operated businesses;
- 34 and
- 35 WHEREAS, today, these companies offer a full-line of alcohol,
- 36 nonalcohol, and light-spirit-based products covering all
- 37 categories: including domestics, imported beers from around the
- 38 world, craft beers, wine coolers, flavored malt beverages, and
- 39 light wines and spirits. These companies have built and sold a
- 40 portfolio of products offering world-class beverages alongside
- 41 excellent customer service for four generations in 22 counties
- 42 that employ more than 230 employees in Mississippi; and

44	truck, both F.E.B Distributing and Capital City Beverages now
45	proudly represent more than 30 supplier partners. They are two of
46	the leading distributors in the State of Mississippi and are
47	positioned to continue the journey of growth and success alongside
48	the ever-expanding Mississippi Gulf Coast and Central Mississippi
