- 27 WHEREAS, as Johnny has been an outstanding golfer, he has
- 28 also given back to the community as a member of Century Club
- 29 Charities since 1999; and
- 30 WHEREAS, he has given a significant amount of his time to
- 31 Century Club Charities, having served as President from 2012-2014,
- 32 and since 2018, he has served as Treasurer; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Johnny has achieved much success on and off the golf
- 34 course, including a deserved induction to the Mississippi Golf
- 35 Association Hall of Fame, and in further acknowledgment of his
