## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 131

- A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE BELMONT HIGH SCHOOL "LADY CARDINALS" GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM AND COACH CHRIS
- 3 HIGGINBOTTOM FOR AN EXCITING WIN AGAINST REGIONAL RIVAL BOONEVILLE
- 4 IN THE MHSAA 3A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.
- 5 WHEREAS, the Belmont High School "Lady Cardinals" Girls
- 6 Basketball Team led by Coach Chris Higginbottom edged out regional
- 7 rival Booneville 40-39 on March 1, 2024, in an instant classic to
- 8 clinch the 2024 Mississippi High School Activities Association
- 9 (MHSAA) 3A State Championship; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the State Title is the 13th for the storied Belmont
- 11 Girls' Basketball Program, the first since 2021 and the fifth
- 12 under Coach Higginbottom; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Booneville was vying for its second-straight State
- 14 Championship. The "Lady Devils" won the two previous meetings
- 15 this season against Belmont, and like those past two games, the
- 16 Championship bout was neck-and-neck for most of the contest.
- 17 Belmont led it 12-11 after the first quarter and 19-14 at the
- 18 half. Booneville closed the gap in the third quarter and went
- 19 into the fourth facing a 30-28 deficit; and

- 20 WHEREAS, when Belmont star Carlie Brock fouled out with 1:08
- 21 to go and sent Booneville to the line in a tie game, it looked
- 22 like the "Lady Cardinals" were defeated, but Coach Chris
- Higginbottom's "Lady Cardinals" pulled out a 40-39 win over their 23
- 24 regional rival to clinch the 2023-2024 Class 3A State Championship
- 25 at the Mississippi Coliseum; and
- WHEREAS, Belmont's Hailey Ivey's late-game heroics served as 26
- 27 exclamation points at the end of an outstanding individual
- 28 performance. The junior finished with a game-high 17 points and
- 29 earned MVP honors; and
- 30 WHEREAS, "I've coached in eight State Championship games
- since I came to Belmont 19 years ago, "Coach Higginbottom said. 31
- 32 "And in seven of those games, we faced a team from our own region
- in the title game.... These games usually come down to one or two 33
- 34 possessions, and who steps up and makes a play. That's why I'm so
- 35 proud of our girls for playing together and finding a way to win";
