House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2425

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. Section 23-15-907, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 23-15-907. (1) For purposes of this section, the following 9 words shall have the meanings as defined herein unless the context 10 clearly indicates otherwise: (a) "Caregiver" means an individual who provides 11 12 medical, health care assistance or other assistance to the person 13 to whom the ballot was mailed in a residence, hospital, long term care facility, nursing home, hospice facility, assisted living 14 15 center, assisted living facility, assisted living home, 16 residential care institution, adult day health care facility,

- 17 adult foster care home or other similar facility or institution.
- "Family member" means an individual who is related 18 (b)
- 19 by blood, marriage, adoption or legal guardianship to the person
- 20 to whom the ballot was mailed.
- "Household member" means an individual who resides 21
- 22 at the same residence as the person to whom the ballot was mailed.

- 23 (* * *2) A person shall not knowingly collect and transmit
- 24 a ballot that was mailed to another person, except as follows:
- 25 (a) An election official while engaged in official
- 26 duties as authorized by law.
- 27 (b) An employee of the United States Postal Service
- 28 while engaged in official duties as authorized by law.
- 29 (c) Any other individual who is allowed by federal law
- 30 to collect and transmit United States mail while engaged in
- 31 official duties as authorized by law.
- 32 (d) A family member, household member, or caregiver of
- 33 the person to whom the ballot was mailed.
- 34 (e) A common carrier that transports goods from one
- 35 place to another for a fee. No parcel shall contain more than a
- 36 single ballot.
- 37 (* * *3) Any violation of this section shall be subject to
- 38 the penalties of Section 97-13-37.
- 39 (4) Any voter who requires assistance to vote by reason of
- 40 blindness, disability, or inability to read or write may be given
- 41 assistance by a person of the voter's choice, other than the
- 42 voter's employer or agent of that employer or officer or agent of
- 43 the voter's union, or a candidate whose name is on the ballot, or
- 44 by a spouse, parent, sibling or child of a candidate whose name is
- 45 on the ballot, or by a poll watcher who is observing the polling
- 46 place on election day; however, a candidate for public office or
- 47 the spouse, parent or child of a candidate may provide assistance
- 48 upon request of any voter who is related within the first degree.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2024.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-907, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DEFINE "CAREGIVER", "FAMILY MEMBER" AND "HOUSEHOLD MEMBER" FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE BALLOT HARVESTING LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
