SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.549, Mississippi Code of 1972, 6 7 is amended as follows: 8 27-19-56.549. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 9 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 10 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 11 12 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 13 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (4) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 14 15 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 16 supporter of any one (1) of the following: 17 (a) Mississippi Association of Nurse Practitioners; Seabee Historical Foundation; 18 (b) 19 Saint Stanislaus College in Bay Saint Louis, 20 Mississippi; 21 Vancleave Live Oak Choctaw; (d)

- 53 (3) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized

- 59 as prescribed by the department. The portion of the additional

- 62 (4) * * * Any person applying for a distinctive license tag

- 94 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected

- 96 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section

- 98 (6) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 99 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under

- this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 106 In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (7) 107 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 108 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 109 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 110 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 111 112 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 113 114 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 115 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed on June 29, 2024.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.549, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS TO SUPPORTERS OF CLARKDALE HIGH SCHOOL IN LAUDERDALE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
