1 **AMEND** on line 50 after the comma by deleting all the language
2 through 97-3-54.1 on line 55 and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following:

4 "except as otherwise provided in this subsection (2),"

5 **AMEND further** on line 74 by deleting all the language after
6 the word "except" through "97-3-54.1" on line 78 and inserting in
7 lieu thereof the following:

8 "as otherwise provided in this Section 2,"



9 **AMEND further** on line 123 after "opinions," by deleting all
10 the language through "97-3-54.1" on line 127 and inserting in lieu
11 thereof the following:

12 "except as otherwise provided in this Section 3,"

13 **AMEND further** on line 152 after "opinions," by deleting all
14 the language through 97-3-54.1 on line 156 and inserting in lieu
15 thereof the following:

16 "except as otherwise provided in this Section 4,"

17 **AMEND further** on line 149 by deleting the words "voter
18 fraud,".

19 **AMEND further** on line 59 after the period, line 83 before the
20 word "Whenever", line 131 after the period, and line 160 after the
21 period by inserting the following:

22 "A person who is convicted of arson, bribery, perjury, armed
23 robbery, as provided in Section 97-3-79, carjacking, embezzlement,
24 if the value and/or amount is Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or
25 more, murder, rape, statutory rape, voter fraud, sexual battery,
26 as provided in Section 97-3-95, or human trafficking, as provided
27 in Section 97-3-54.1, shall have his or her right to vote revoked



28 upon conviction, and shall not be eligible to have his or her
29 right to vote restored."

30 **AMEND further** on line 35 after "arson," by inserting the
31 words, "bribery, perjury,".

32 **AMEND further** on lines 48 and 120 by deleting "bribery,".

33 **AMEND further** on lines 49 and 121 by deleting "perjury,".

34 **AMEND further** the title to conform.
