- 1 **AMEND** by inserting the following after line 299:
- 2 " (5) (a) During any period of the regular scholastic year or
- 3 extended school year programs in which academic instruction is
- 4 being provided to students upon the campuses of a public and
- 5 private elementary or secondary schools, school resource officers,
- 6 employed by a local law enforcement agency to provide community
- 7 policing efforts to combat school violence and improve student and
- 8 school safety, shall maintain an active and visible presence upon
- 9 the school campus to which he or she is assigned under the program
- 10 defined in Section 1 of this act. For purposes of this section,
- 11 "regular scholastic year" means the minimum one hundred eighty
- 12 (180) days which public schools are required to be kept in session
- 13 under Section 37-13-63 to constitute a scholastic year. "Extended
- 14 school year programs" means those programs authorized by law,



13	which extend beyond the one hundred eighty-day term of a regular
16	scholastic year, including summer school instruction. In the
17	performance of his or her duties, a school resource officer shall
18	report for duty on the campus of the school of assignment not
19	later than one (1) hour before the start of each school day on
20	Monday through Friday, and remain thereon for one (1) hour after
21	the conclusion of normal daily instruction. No school resource
22	officer shall be required to work on Saturday or Sunday, unless a
23	school sponsored event is hosted upon the school campus which the
24	school resource officer has been assigned, which such events shall
25	include extracurricular and cocurricular activities.
26	(b) When school is not in session (i.e. holidays,
27	summer vacation, fall breaks, declarations of emergency which
28	suspend the requirements for school attendance, etc.), the school
29	resource officer shall report to his or her immediate supervisor
30	within the local law enforcement agency of employment for further
31	assignment of duties that are directly related to activities and
32	functions of the local law enforcement agency.
33	(c) Notwithstanding a school resource officer's
34	permanent employment with the local law enforcement agency with
35	whom a local school governing authority has entered into a
36	Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) or an interlocal agreement for
37	the assignment of a school resource officer, the employing local

law enforcement agency shall not require a school resource officer

to leave his or her assigned post at a school during the time

40	specified for the performance of his or her duties as prescribed
41	in paragraph (a) of this subsection to perform work duties
42	directly related to activities and functions of the local law
43	enforcement agency, unless it has been determined by the chief law
44	enforcement officer of the employing agency that exigent
45	circumstances exist, which have created an emergency situation of
46	an impending catastrophic nature that requires swift action to
47	prevent imminent danger to life, substantial harm to the public
48	welfare or serious damage to property."
