(c) Any other individual who is allowed by federal law
to collect and transmit United States mail while engaged in
official duties as authorized by law.

34 (e) A common carrier that transports goods from one
 35 place to another for a fee. No parcel shall contain more than a
 36 single ballot.

37 (***3) Any violation of this section shall be subject to 38 the penalties of Section 97-13-37.

39 (4) Any voter who requires assistance to vote by reason of
40 blindness, disability, or inability to read or write may be given

41 assistance by a person of the voter's choice, other than the

- 42 voter's employer or agent of that employer or officer or agent of
- 43 the voter's union, or a candidate whose name is on the ballot, or
- 44 by a spouse, parent, sibling or child of a candidate whose name is
- 45 on the ballot, or by a poll watcher who is observing the polling
