Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

18 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions 19 of Higher Learning, acting on behalf of the University of 20 Mississippi, is authorized to enter into a long-term lease of all 21 or any portion of real property under its control and possession 22 for the purpose of developing academic buildings, housing, dining 23 halls, parking facilities, and/or other spaces (including retail developments) for the benefit of the university. The property 24 25 shall be leased for a period not to exceed thirty (30) years, with 26 the option for two (2) ten-year lease extensions.



- 27 (2) The lease and any amendments to the lease of all or any
- 28 portion of the real property authorized for lease under subsection
- 29 (1) of this section shall be subject to the approval of the Board
- 30 of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning. The
- 31 approved lease and any amendments to the lease shall not be
- 32 cancelled by successor boards based on the binding successor
- 33 doctrine.
- 34 **SECTION 2.** (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 35 of Higher Learning, acting on behalf of the University of
- 36 Mississippi, is authorized to enter into a long-term sublease of
- 37 all or any portion of the real property described in Section 1 of
- 38 this act which is under its control and possession for a period
- 39 not to exceed a term of thirty (30) years, with the option for two
- 40 (2) ten-year lease extensions.
- 41 (2) The sublease and any amendments to the sublease of all
- 42 or any portion of the real property described in Section 1 of this
- 43 act shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of
- 44 State Institutions of Higher Learning. The approved sublease and
- 45 any amendments to the sublease shall not be cancelled by successor
- 46 boards based on the binding successor doctrine.
- 47 **SECTION 3.** If all or any portion of the property described
- 48 in Section 1 of this act is leased, the University of Mississippi,
- 49 with the approval of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- of Higher Learning, is authorized to negotiate all aspects of any
- 51 lease or sublease and any terms and ancillary agreements



- 52 pertaining to any lease or sublease as may be reasonably necessary
- 53 to effectuate the intent and purposes of this section and to
- 54 ensure a fair and equitable return to the state.
- 55 **SECTION 4.** (1) All proceeds derived or received from the
- 56 agreements and leases entered into under this section shall be
- 57 deposited into a special fund and expended only for the use and
- 58 benefit of the University of Mississippi.
- 59 (2) At the end of the lease term provided in this act, the
- 60 property leased under the authority provided herein shall revert
- 61 to the University of Mississippi.
- 62 (3) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights
- 63 to the real property leased under Section 1 of this act.
- 64 (4) The Department of Finance and Administration is
- 65 authorized to correct any discrepancies in the property described
- 66 in Section 1 of this act.
- 67 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 68 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE

3 UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI TO ENTER INTO A LONG-TERM LEASE OF ALL

- 4 OR ANY PORTION OF REAL PROPERTY UNDER ITS CONTROL AND POSSESSION
- 5 FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING ACADEMIC BUILDINGS, HOUSING, DINING
- 6 HALLS, PARKING FACILITIES, AND/OR OTHER SPACES, INCLUDING RETAIL
- 7 DEVELOPMENTS, FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE UNIVERSITY; TO PROVIDE THAT
- 8 ANY SUCH PROPERTY SHALL BE LEASED FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 30
- 9 YEARS; TO SET CERTAIN OTHER LEASE TERMS AND TO REQUIRE ANY LEASE
- 10 TO BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF I.H.L.; TO AUTHORIZE THE



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- 11 UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI TO NEGOTIATE ALL ASPECTS OF ANY LEASE
- 12 WITH THE APPROVAL OF I.H.L.; TO PROVIDE THAT ALL PROCEEDS DERIVED
- 13 FROM ANY SUCH LEASE SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO A SPECIAL FUND ONLY
- 14 FOR THE USE OF THE UNIVERSITY; TO REQUIRE ANY PROPERTY LEASED
- 15 UNDER THIS ACT TO REVERT BACK TO THE UNIVERSITY AT THE END OF THE
- 16 LEASE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
