Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 634

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. Section 45-9-131, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

(1) Upon approval of the governing authority of the municipality or county, a member of any municipal or county 9 10 law enforcement agency who retires under any state retirement 11 system or leaves such employment after being employed for ten (10) 12 continuous years of service may be allowed to purchase, as his or 13 her personal property, one (1) sidearm which was issued to the law 14 enforcement officer by the law enforcement agency from which he or 15 she retired or by whom he or she was employed at the time of 16 The governing authority of the municipality or county that death. 17 employed the member of the law enforcement agency shall determine 18 an agreed upon price to be paid for the sidearm.

19 (2) Upon approval of the director of a state agency, board 20 or commission, a law enforcement officer employed by a state 21 agency, board or commission who retires under any state retirement 22 system may be allowed to purchase, as his or her personal

The state agency, 25 board or commission that employed the law enforcement officer 26 shall determine an agreed upon price to be paid for the sidearm. 27 (3) Subject to the satisfactory completion of any required 28 background checks, the next of kin of a law enforcement officer who is killed in the line of duty is authorized to purchase the 29

30 sidearm that was issued to the officer. The amount to be paid for 31 any * * * <u>sidearm</u> purchased under the authority of this subsection 32 shall be an agreed upon price as determined by the appropriate 33 governmental authority who employed the officer.

35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
