Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1298

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 14 **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section, the
- 15 following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed
- 16 herein unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 17 (a) "Wild turkey" means the game bird *Meleagris*
- 18 gallopavo.
- 19 (b) "Stamp" means the state wild turkey stamp, either
- 20 in its physical or electronic form, furnished by the commission.
- 21 A stamp is a specialized permit required for hunting wild turkeys,
- 22 with proceeds directly dispersed into the conservation,
- 23 management, protection or scientific research of wild turkeys.
- 24 (c) "Harvest tag" means the electronic tool used to
- 25 serve as an inventory of the annual bag limit allotted to
- 26 individual wild turkey hunters. Harvest tags are invalidated upon
- 27 the harvest of a wild turkey.
- 28 (d) "Nongovernmental entity" means a nonprofit
- 29 organization primarily concerned with the protection and

- 30 conservation of land and natural resources, as evidenced by its
- 31 organizational documents.
- 32 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person sixteen (16) years
- 33 of age or older to hunt or take wild turkeys during any open wild
- 34 turkey season in the State of Mississippi without first having
- 35 procured a stamp. The electronic stamp on file with the
- 36 commission shall serve as proof of procurement.
- 37 (3) The fee to nonresident hunters for each stamp shall be
- 38 Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). There shall be no fee for resident
- 39 hunters. Each stamp shall be valid through the final day of the
- 40 spring wild turkey season following its purchase. After its
- 41 expiration, another stamp must be procured in order to hunt or
- 42 take wild turkeys in a future open wild turkey season.
- 43 (4) The commission may make the procurement of harvest tags
- 44 dependent upon the purchase of a stamp.
- 45 (5) The commission shall determine the form of the stamp.
- 46 The commission shall furnish physical stamps to bonded agents for
- 47 issuance or sale in the same manner as other types of licenses or
- 48 shall cause the electronic stamp to accrue to the purchaser's
- 49 benefit when purchased from an automated point-of-sale source.
- 50 (6) Any person violating any of the provisions of this
- 51 section shall be quilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
- 52 shall be fined not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more
- 53 than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) as prescribed in Section
- 54 49-7-101.

- 55 (7) All revenue from the proceeds of stamps shall be
- 56 <u>deposited into the Wild Turkey Stamp Fund created in this section</u>
- 57 and shall only be used and expended for the following objectives:
- 58 (a) Paying administrative or processing costs
- 59 associated with an electronic harvest tag program, or any other
- 60 program governing or regulating the harvest of wild turkeys;
- 61 (b) Restoring, enhancing or protecting wild turkey
- 62 populations or their habitats on public or private lands in
- 63 Mississippi as prescribed by the department;
- (c) Funding scientific research, as conducted by
- 65 qualified professionals, into the ecology or management of wild
- 66 turkeys, their habitats or their predators; and
- 67 (d) Increasing access to publicly available turkey
- 68 hunting opportunities.
- 69 (8) Proceeds from stamps may be used as matching funds or
- 70 fiscal leverage to secure grants or other financial awards are
- 71 deemed to align with the objectives in subsection (7) of this
- 72 section.
- 73 (9) The commission may enter into agreements with other
- 74 state, federal or nongovernmental entities to execute the
- 75 objectives in subsection (7) of this section.
- 76 (10) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund
- 77 <u>to be designated as the "Wild Turkey Stamp Fund," which shall</u>
- 78 consist of funds made available by the Legislature in any manner
- 79 and funds from any other source designated for deposit into such
- 80 fund. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a

- 81 separate and special fund, separate and apart from the State
- 82 General Fund. Monies in the fund shall be used by the department
- 83 or the commission, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to
- 84 <u>execute the objectives in subsections (7) and (8) of this section.</u>
- 85 <u>Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal</u>
- 86 year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any
- 87 <u>investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fund</u>
- 88 shall be deposited to the credit of the fund.
- 89 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a new
- 90 section in Title 49, Chapter 7, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 91 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 92 and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2024.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL PERSONS 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO PROCURE A WILD TURKEY STAMP BEFORE HUNTING WILD TURKEYS IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO ESTABLISH THE FEE FOR NONRESIDENT HUNTERS AND PROVIDE THAT THERE SHALL BE NO FEE FOR RESIDENT HUNTERS; TO

- 5 PROVIDE FOR THE FURNISHING OF THE STAMP; TO SET PENALTIES FOR
- 6 VIOLATIONS; TO PROVIDE THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH FUNDS RAISED FROM
- 7 THE SALE OF STAMPS MAY BE EXPENDED; TO CREATE THE WILD TURKEY
- 8 STAMP FUND AS A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR USE BY THE
- 9 DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS OR THE COMMISSION ON
- 10 WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS, UPON LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATION, IN
- 11 FURTHERANCE OF THE OBJECTIVES OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED
- 12 PURPOSES.
