## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1785

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the
8	Pat Harrison Waterway District, for the purpose of defraying the
9	expenses of the district for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
11	\$ 7,056,595.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the
13	provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
15	Permanent: 52
16	Time-Limited: 0
17	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
19	Services for Fiscal Year 2026 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2025 funds
20	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
21	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 budget by the Mississippi
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- 22 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's personal
- 23 services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board shall
- 24 publish. In accordance with applicable laws, if an agency
- 25 determines that its personal services amount is insufficient, the
- 26 agency must contact the State Personnel Board. Any adjustment to
- 27 the personal services amount must be approved by the State
- 28 Personnel Director and the State Fiscal Officer after consultation
- 29 with the Legislative Budget Office. Any adjustment shall be
- 30 reported to the Legislative Budget Office and the House and Senate
- 31 Appropriations Chairmen. The agency's personal services
- 32 appropriation may consist of restricted funds for approved
- 33 vacancies for Fiscal Year 2025 that may not be utilized for active
- 34 Fiscal Year 2024 headcount. It shall be the agency's
- 35 responsibility to ensure that the funds provided for vacancies are
- 36 used to increase headcount and not for promotions, title changes,
- 37 in-range salary adjustments, or any other mechanism for increasing
- 38 salaries for current employees. If the State Personnel Board
- 39 determines that an agency has used provided vacancy funds for any
- 40 of the mechanisms previously listed, the State Personnel Board
- 41 shall not process any additional salary actions for the agency in
- 42 the current fiscal year, except for new hires determined by the
- 43 State Personnel Board to be essential for the agency. It is the
- 44 Legislature's intention that no employee salary falls below the
- 45 minimum salary established by the Mississippi State Personnel
- 46 Board.

47 Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and 48 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to 49 50 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2025 do 51 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If 52 the agency's projected cost for Fiscal Year 2025 exceeds the 53 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be 54

56 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or 58 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 59 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 60 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 61 62 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 63 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 64 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

73 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

74 Pat Harrison Waterway District shall maintain complete accounting

75 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

76 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

77 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year

78 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to

80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided

82 during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

83 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
84 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
85 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
86 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
87 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
88 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

90 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills

97 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

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- 98 **SECTION 6.** The Pat Harrison Waterway District shall provide
- 99 a report on completed park facilities repairs. This report shall
- 100 be provided to the Legislature by December 1, 2024, and shall
- 101 include photos of stated repairs. The Pat Harrison Waterway
- 102 District shall provide the Joint Legislative Budget Committee a
- 103 copy of this report with the subsequent fiscal year's budget
- 104 submission.
- 105 **SECTION 7.** The Pat Harrison Waterway District shall provide
- 106 an annual five-year plan containing a prioritized list detailing
- 107 the purposes, goals and projected costs of projects which it
- 108 intends to implement or is in the process of implementing. This
- 109 report shall be provided to the Legislature on or before July 15
- 110 of each year as required in Section 51-15-119(2). The Pat
- 111 Harrison Waterway District shall provide the Joint Legislative
- 112 Budget Committee a copy of this report with the current year's
- 113 budget submission.
- 114 SECTION 8. The Pat Harrison Waterway District shall provide
- 115 an annual audit of the district operations. This report shall be
- 116 provided to the Legislature as required in Section 51-15-119(3).
- 117 The Pat Harrison Waterway District shall provide the Joint
- 118 Legislative Budget Committee a copy of this report with the
- 119 current year's budget submission.
- 120 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 121 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 122 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 123 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their

124	appropriation	and that	the	responsible	officers.	either	personally	;
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- 125 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 126 actions contrary to this provision.
- 127 **SECTION 10.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
- 128 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
- 129 or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 130 **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2024.
