## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1815

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying
9	salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys, assistant
10	district attorneys, criminal investigators, tort claims
11	assessments, and paying office expenses of district attorneys for
12	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
13	\$ 30,871,543.00.
14	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
15	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State
16	Prosecutor Compensation Fund, referred to in Section 99-19-73,
17	Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of paying salaries of
18	assistant district attorneys of the state as authorized in Section
19	25-31-5(1) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending
20	June 30, 2025\$ 486,932.00.

H. B. 1815 PAGE 1 21 SECTION 3. None of the funds authorized in this section 22 shall be used to reimburse district attorneys or their staff for 23 taxable meals incurred within their geographical district.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated herein, office expenses
of district attorneys as authorized by Section 25-31-8,
Mississippi Code of 1972, in the amount of One Million Six Hundred
Sixty-six Thousand Dollars (\$1,666,000.00).

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 28 29 district attorneys and assistant district attorneys of the state 30 shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related 31 to the expenditure of all funds appropriated in this act and that 32 those records shall be in the same format and level of details as 33 maintained for Fiscal Year 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the budget requests for Fiscal Year 2026 34 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a 35 36 format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of 37 detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process for each agency and institution appropriated funds within the 38 39 provisions of this act.

40 SECTION 6. Of the funds provided in Section 1 of this act, 41 Three Hundred Seventy-one Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-nine 42 Dollars (\$371,679.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 43 provided for two (2) full-time assistant district attorneys and 44 (1) full-time criminal investigator pursuant to House Bill 1020, 45 2023 Regular Session, and engrossed in Section 25-31-37, 46 Mississippi Code of 1972.

H. B. 1815 PAGE 2 47 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that with 48 the funds provided herein, the district attorneys shall submit 49 their Five-Year Strategic Plan(s) as required in Section 50 27-103-129(1), Mississippi Code of 1972.

51 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 52 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 53 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 54 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 55 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 56 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

57 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2024.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING 2 SALARIES AND TRAVEL EXPENSES OF DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND ASSISTANT 3 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS OF THE STATE AND PAYING OFFICE EXPENSES OF 4 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025.
