Section 29-5-205, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

48 amended as follows:

49 29-5-205. (1) The Executive Director of the Department of 50 Finance and Administration or his or her designee shall implement, 51 supervise and administer improvement projects paid for with funds 52 from the Capitol Complex Improvement District Project Fund <u>or</u> 53 <u>other funds appropriated by the Legislature</u>, and may accept funds 54 and services from other sources to use for the purposes provided 55 in Sections 29-5-201 through 29-5-217.

Subject to the limitation on funds provided for in
Section 29-5-215, the executive director may employ persons as he
or she considers necessary for the proper implementation,
supervision and administration of improvement projects funded, in
whole or in part, by funds from the Capitol Complex Improvement
District Project Fund.

(3) Subject to the limitation on funds provided for in
Section 29-5-215, the Department of Finance and Administration

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DEFINE THE AUTHORITY OF THE CAPITOL COMPLEX IMPROVEMENT JISTRICT RELATIVE TO THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES, PROPERTY AND DEBRIS; TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-205, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION MAY PAY FOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FROM ANY FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
