# Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 1471

# Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12 SECTION 1. Section 77-19-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13 amended as follows:

14 77-19-7. (1) The Office of Broadband Expansion and 15 Accessibility of Mississippi (BEAM) shall serve as the state 16 broadband office to review applications and make determinations 17 and awards for projects to provide broadband access in unserved or 18 underserved areas using the BEAM Fund created pursuant to this 19 chapter.

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(2) It shall be the duty and responsibility of BEAM to:

accessibility efforts on behalf of the state to ensure an
effective and efficient use of broadband grant funds;

(b) Develop the plan and application for federal grant programs and for sub-grantees to receive funds from said federal grants;

(c) Develop rules and procedures, if necessary and in
 accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, to implement a
 competitive statewide broadband grant program;

30 (d) Coordinate all information provided by broadband 31 service providers, including all broadband mapping efforts for the 32 state. All information provided by a broadband service provider 33 pursuant to this chapter shall be presumed to be confidential, 34 proprietary, and subject to exemption from disclosure under state 35 and federal law and shall not be subject to disclosure except in 36 the form of a map where information that could be used to 37 determine provider-specific information about the network of the broadband service providers is not disclosed. 38 Such 39 provider-specific information shall not be released to any person 40 without written permission of the submitting broadband service 41 provider. In no instance shall a broadband service provider be 42 required to provide any data beyond that which it is required to provide to the Federal Communications Commission pursuant to 47 43 USC Section 641 et seq.; \* \* \* 44

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45 Apply for and receive federal grants or funds, (e) 46 including, but not limited to, Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund established by Section 604 of the Social Security Act, as added by 47 Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, and the 48 49 Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment Program established by the 50 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021, and all other federal broadband grant programs and any state support grant 51 52 programs **\* \* \*;** and

53 (f) Grant final determinations for awards for projects 54 to provide broadband access in unserved or underserved areas 55 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section no later than sixty 56 (60) days after publishing a preliminary determination of an award 57 on BEAM's website pursuant to this chapter or thirty (30) days 58 after this law goes into effect, whichever is later, unless BEAM 59 determines that a proposed project includes an area where 60 broadband services currently are deployed, or where construction 61 is scheduled to be completed within one (1) year after the date of 62 application.

(3) To effectuate the purposes of this chapter, any department, division, board, bureau, committee, institution or agency of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, shall, at the request of the Director of BEAM, provide the assistance, information and data needed to enable BEAM to carry out its duties.

24/SS08/HB1471A.J PAGE 3 69 An officer or employee of BEAM shall not accept or (4) 70 receive any gratuity, gift, gift in-kind, money, emolument, or any 71 other pecuniary benefit, either directly or indirectly, from any 72 broadband service provider, vendor, contractor, subcontractor, 73 nonprofit organization or association that does business with or 74 contracts with BEAM, or any designee, employee, agent, officer, or 75 representative of such broadband service provider, vendor, 76 contractor, subcontractor, nonprofit organization or association. 77 For purposes of this section, the term "emolument" includes 78 salary, donations, contributions, loans, stock tips, vacations and 79 trips.

80 There is created within the State Treasury the ( \* \* \*5) 81 "Broadband Expansion and Accessibility of Mississippi (BEAM) Fund" 82 for the purposes of the expansion and accessibility of broadband 83 in unserved and underserved areas. The fund shall consist of all 84 monies designated, accepted or appropriated by the State of 85 Mississippi for broadband deployment; all monies received from the 86 federal government awarded to or allocated by the state for 87 broadband deployment; and donations, gifts and monies received 88 from any other source, including transfers from other funds or 89 accounts. Disbursements from the fund shall be made by the 90 Department of Finance and Administration upon appropriation by the Legislature in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. 91 92 All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund 93

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94 shall be invested by the State Treasurer in the same manner as

95 monies in the State General Fund and interest earned on the

96 investment of these monies shall be credited to the fund.

97 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

98 and after its passage.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 77-19-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 ALLOW BEAM TO GRANT FINAL DETERMINATIONS FOR AWARDS FOR PROJECTS 3 TO PROVIDE BROADBAND ACCESS IN CERTAIN UNSERVED OR UNDERSERVED AREAS; TO PROHIBIT ANY OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE OFFICE OF 4 5 BROADBAND EXPANSION AND ACCESSIBILITY OF MISSISSIPPI FROM 6 ACCEPTING OR RECEIVING, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, ANY 7 GRATUITY, GIFT, GIFT IN-KIND, MONEY, EMOLUMENT, OR ANY OTHER PECUNIARY BENEFIT FROM ANY BROADBAND SERVICE PROVIDER, VENDOR, 8 9 CONTRACTOR, OR SUBCONTRACTOR THAT DOES BUSINESS WITH OR CONTRACTS 10 WITH THE OFFICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
