## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13	Treasury to the credit of the Office of Capital Post-Conviction
14	Counsel, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Office

15	of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel of the State of Mississippi for
16	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025

18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	this act, the following positions are authorized:
20	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
21	Permanent: 9
22	Time-Limited: 0
23	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
24	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
25	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
26	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
27	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
28	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
29	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
30	Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel shall maintain complete
31	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
32	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
33	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
34	Year 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
35	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be
36	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
37	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
38	provided during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

39	<b>SECTION 5.</b> It is the intention of the Legislature that the
40	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
41	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
42	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
43	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
44	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
45	actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2024.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
